Class A type crimes (more serious) were up by 15% for the month and down by 9% for the fiscal year. Class B type crimes were up by 2% for the month and up by 10% for the fiscal year. Total crimes are up by 10% for the month and down by 2% for the fiscal year.

PATROL DIVISION HIGHLIGHTS

Patrol Division responded 2600 block of Chateau Dr on an aggravated felonious assault that was in progress. The officers arrived and observed the female victim being punched in the nose and head butted in the face which caused her to start bleeding excessively. When the officers attempted to enter the residence in order to arrest the suspect and keep the victim from sustaining further injury the suspect refused to open the door and closed the door in the officer's face. The officers forced their way into the trailer and the suspect started back tracking into the living room and did not listen to commands. The suspect continued to kick and fight with officers. The suspect refused to listen to officers and was verbally and physically aggressive towards them. The officers guided the suspect to the ground where they held him down while he continued to fight with them. Officers held down the suspect's legs and hands to prevent him

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from kicking. The suspect continued to try and kick several times and grabbed onto the officers uniforms several times. After a long struggle, the suspect was taken to the police car where he was transported and lodged at the Muskegon County Jail. The victim was taken to a hospital where she was treated for her injuries.


Patrol Division responded to the 600 block of Norton on a subject that had a gun. It was reported that a male suspect had pointed a handgun at a female and threaten her with it. The suspect then got into a dark colored vehicle and left going east bound on Seaway near Norton. The officer located the vehicle on Seaway near Seminole and conducted a traffic stop on the vehicle. The vehicle eventually pulled over to the right on Seaway Dr on the shoulder near the metal guardrail just west of Peninsula. The officer exited his cruiser and initiated a high risk stop at gun point. The officer observed an object be thrown out of the passenger side of the vehicle, over the guardrail and into the snow. After the occupants were placed in custody the officers searched the area where the object was thrown and located a silver/black 9mm Jimenez handgun in the snow over the guardrail. The officers observed a small hole in the snow, excavated the snow down several inches and found the gun. There were 11 unspent rounds in the magazine and none in the chamber. The suspect confessed to pointing the gun and being in possession of it. The gun was seized as evidence and the suspect was arrested and lodged at the Muskegon County Jail.

Patrol Division responded to the 1400 block of Oregon on a stolen car complaint. The officer arrived and met with the victim who stated she had her gray 2011 Nissan parked in front of the house last night. The victim stated she left her car unlocked with the keys in the car. She last saw the car at 11:00 P.M. the night before. She woke up this morning at 7: A.M. and discovered the car was gone. The officer obtained the description of the vehicle and put out an area broadcast. A Muskegon officer located the victim's car which was on the side of the road on Leahy in the City of Muskegon. The officer checked the car over and found no one in it and it appeared to have no damage. The victim came to the location and the car was returned.

Patrol Division responded to 1000 block of Sternberg on a stolen trailer that had over \$10,000 worth of vitamins in it. The victim advised the trailer was stolen sometime overnight. The officer obtained the description and then put out a broadcast on it. The officer was dispatched to outbound Skyline near US-31 to assist Muskegon PD that had located the stolen trailer. The Muskegon officer advised that he read the BOL regarding the stolen trailer earlier and observed it being pulled down the road. Our officer conducted an investigation and interviewed the driver. It was found that the trailer was stolen. The trailer was returned to the owner and the suspect was charged for larceny. A warrant has been requested.

Total cruiser mileage for the month of December was 25,553 miles.

CALLS FOR SERVICE



During the month of January 2018, the Department recorded 2,134 Computer Aided Dispatch events, including 1,069 calls for service. A total of 830 written reports were generated during the month. The highest number of calls for service occurred on Wednesday.

TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT DATA

Department personnel issued 3 parking tickets and 255 traffic citations in January, which includes those issued as the result of crash investigations. Citations were issued in 50.6% of the traffic crashes that occurred this month.

TRAINING

In the month of January, twenty five officers including command attended over 200 hours of training.

Seven command officers and fifteen officers attended a Legal Update training that was held in Grandville MI. This is an eight hour class where the officers were updated on the law changes and new laws that had passed. This training is held once a year and all officers are required to attend.

Two command officers were sent to a supervisor's school that was held at Grand Valley State University. This class focused on leadership and motivation.

Four command officers and one patrol officer attended an eight hour Emergency Response Training that focuses on entries and searches in a building.

Twelve officers including command attended a one hour Human Trafficking training put on by the Muskegon County Human Trafficking Task Force. This was held at the Norton Shores P.D.

DETECTIVE BUREAU HIGHLIGHTS

During the month of January the Detective Bureau was assigned six new cases. One case was cleared by arrest, warrants or other means. The remaining cases are still under investigation.

MAJOR ACTIVITIES

The Detective Bureau investigated a forgery where a female suspect stole the victim's checkbook and allegedly cashed two checks at a financial institution in Norton Shores. The case has been submitted to the prosecutor's office for review.

The Detective Bureau is investigating two child abuse cases that occurred in the 800 block of Aztec and the 900 block of Bowline. Both investigations will be submitted to the prosecutor's office soon.

The Detective Bureau assisted the road patrol division with a larceny of a utility trailer. The trailer was located in the City of Muskegon. A search warrant was conducted at a local business. Charges are pending.

The United States Attorney's Office indicted four men for the murder of Deangelo Phippen which occurred at Henry and Norton on December 29, 2016.

The Detective Bureau signed a total of 54 arrest warrants this month which included warrants from the Patrol Division. Over 30 hours were spent at the Muskegon County Court building obtaining warrants, meeting with prosecutors, picking up and dropping off paperwork.

On January 11th, Detective Morningstar attended legal update training.

WEST MICHIGAN ENFORCEMENT TEAM (WEMET)

The Detective from WEMET assisted with a search warrant in 3100 block of Temple. Evidence collected was .5 gram of crack cocaine, 18 pills, and \$3,678.00 in cash. The resident of the home was lodged on possession of narcotic charges.

The Detective from WEMET assisted with a search warrant in the 2400 block of Russell. 51.7 grams of crack cocaine, and \$4,820.00 in cash was seized. An arrest warrant was issued for the offender.

The Detective from WEMET investigated a narcotic overdose death in the 800 block of Brookside.

The Detective from WEMET assisted in the seizure of over 56 grams of crack cocaine, 5 grams of methamphetamine, and 14 grams of marijuana, one firearm and \$12,360.00 in cash during the month of January.
