Class A type crimes (more serious) were up by 4.2% for the month and down by 12.3% for the fiscal year. Class B type crimes were up by 21% for the month and down by 22% for the fiscal year. Total crimes are up by 10% for the month and down by 16.2% for the fiscal year.

PATROL DIVISION HIGHLIGHTS

Patrol Division responded to the 1100 block of E Sherman, for a medical assist. The caller advised a male was inside the vehicle trying to wake someone passed out in the vehicle. The male in the driver’s seat was not waking up. Through the investigation by the officers it was determined that the subject had taken a substantial amount of Narotin, a prescription drug and had overdosed. The officers administered medical assistance until the paramedics and ambulance arrived. The subject was transported to the hospital.

Patrol Division responded to the Hidden Cove Park at 2332 hours, after the 2200 hours closing time for the park. The officer observed a vehicle that had its engine and lights off. The officer made contact with the occupants in the two vehicles in the parking lot. While talking with the subjects the officer observed and located a crack pipe and another pipe that were in plain sight in the vehicle. The pipes were seen in the inside of the passenger side door. Other items found at the scene were drug paraphernalia, a baggy with white residue and a razor with white residue on it. The subjects were identified and released. Warrants are being sought when the crime lab determines

what the white substance is. Officers continue to patrol the parks to keep criminal elements away such as drug and alcohol use.

Patrol Division responded to the 2400 block of Pembroke on a child abuse complaint. When the officers arrived on scene they walked through the residence. The officers observed trash everywhere, dirty diapers, and feces clogging the toilet and cat feces on the floor. The kids were also dirty and they didn't see any clean clothes inside. The officers spoke with Child Protective Services intake and advised them of the situation. A CPS officer arrived on scene and said the children would not be staying there tonight. The children were taken to a safe place where they were bathed, fed and given clean clothing. The officers completed their investigation which includes the child abuse/neglect form and faxed it to CPS. The officer has sent the report to the Muskegon Prosecutor's Office for charges on the parent for child neglect.


Patrol Division responded to the 2800 block of Worden on an assault that was taking place outside in the front of the home. Officers arrived and found a female victim bleeding from her face, head and neck area. The victim stated she was assaulted by her boyfriend who had left prior to officer's arrival. The victim stated her boyfriend began hitting and punching her in the face and she fell to the ground where he then kicked her in the face, head, and on the body. He then picked up a glass perfume bottle that was in the car and threw it at the victim. The bottle hit the roof of the car and then hit the victim in the head. He picked up the perfume bottle and then threw it at another female victim striking her in the face. The victim suffered a gash on her head roughly an inch long and the other victim had an abrasion on her left arm from the glass perfume bottle. The suspect was later apprehended and charged with domestic assault and aggravated assault. He was transported and lodged at the Muskegon County Jail.

Patrol Division responded to the 1900 block of Forest Park on what appeared to be bullets that had made contact with a house. The complainant was awakened by a sound that he described sounded like someone hitting the side of his house with a bat. The complainant said that it shook his bedroom window. The complainant noticed two holes in his siding today at around lunch time. The officers observed what appeared to be multiple holes in the siding and concluded it was done with a small caliber gun. The siding was removed to check for any bullets. The area was searched using a metal detector and the neighbors were interviewed. The investigation remains active.

Patrol Division received an anonymous tip from the Muskegon Tip Line with information that two subjects staying in a hotel room located in Norton Shores had warrants and were selling narcotics. The information was confirmed that the subjects in the room did in fact have warrants for their arrest. The officers obtained a search warrant and then executed the search warrant using the motel master key on the room that the offenders were staying in. Officers located syringes in the top drawer of the dresser along with heroin and 3 vials labeled Naloxone with a clear liquid inside. The suspects were arrested on the outstanding warrants and charged with possession of narcotics. They were lodged at the Muskegon County jail.

Total cruiser mileage for the month of June was 24,644 miles.

CALLS FOR SERVICE



During the month of June 2017, the Department recorded 1,432 Computer Aided Dispatch events, including 1,238 calls for service. A total of 785 written reports were generated during the month. The highest number of calls for service occurred on Friday.

TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT DATA

Department personnel issued 27 parking tickets and 212 traffic citations in June, which includes those issued as the result of crash investigations. Citations were issued in 59% of the traffic crashes that occurred this month.

TRAINING

All officers and command attended an eight hour course in Physical Control Tactics. This training is put on every year by our instructors held at the Mona Shores High School. This training ensures officers understand the winning mindset and pre-assault indicators. They are to be versed in liability/current case law, and report writing. The instructors make sure that the officers are trained properly in control holds, take downs, pressure points, and handcuffing tactics. With this type of training it will assist the officers in keeping in compliance with the Norton Shores Standard Operating Procedures.

All officers and command were trained on the new procedure on how to obtain warrants and subpoenas via internet/computer. The Muskegon County Prosecutor's Office and Courts are going to a new system and want to be paper less in the upcoming 2017-2018 year. This training was set up by the Muskegon County Courts. They are planning to implement the system in August of 2017.

Command went to a six hour training involving a new program that pays special attention with children that are in need of assistance. This training covered the Michigan Initiative which is tailored to reflect the needs and issues affecting children in Michigan that have been exposed or experienced trauma, violence or negative confrontations. This training is for teachers, law enforcement officials, and therapists that can help or assist these children to get them counseling quicker and understand what they had just gone through.

DETECTIVE BUREAU HIGHLIGHTS

During the month of June the Detective Bureau was assigned thirteen new cases. Four cases were cleared by arrest, warrants or other means. The remaining cases are still under investigation.

MAJOR ACTIVITIES

The Detective Bureau is investigation a Criminal Sexual Conduct (CSC) complaint that occurred at the Reserves apartment complex where an 18 year old male had sex with a 13 year old female. The investigation is still on going.

The Detective Bureau investigated a possible vulnerable adult abuse when an elderly residence noticed they were missing financial documents after a recent visit from their adult son. Detectives checked the citizens' bank records and determined nothing was

missing from the complainant's bank accounts. The detective assisted the elderly citizen in setting up fraud detection on her accounts.

The Detective Bureau investigated a complaint at Mona Shores Middle School where nude photographs were being shared between students on their cell phones. All the devices containing the nude photographs were factory reset and everyone involved were lectured and discipline was handled by the parents.

Detective Morningstar instructed Rape Aggression Defense (RAD), a women's self-defense program, by leading an interactive discussion and a hands-on techniques training during the month of June.

On June 14th - Detective Sergeant VanderStelt attended Lakeshore Human Trafficking Task Force meeting.

On June 21st members of the Detective Bureau attended a first responder's luncheon at New Life Community Church.

On June 27th and June 29th all members of the Detective Bureau attended department control tactics training at the Mona Shores High School.

The Detective Bureau signed a total of 58 arrest warrants this month which included warrants from the Patrol Division. Over 30 hours were spent at the Muskegon County Court building obtaining warrants, meeting with prosecutors, picking up and dropping off paperwork.

WEST MICHIGAN ENFORCEMENT TEAM (WEMET)

The Detective from WEMET assisted on two search warrants involving the same offender. The first search warrant occurred in the 100 block of Maplewood and the second was in the 1400 block of Woodside. The detectives located 42 grams of heroin and lodged the offender for possession with intent to deliver heroin.

The Detective from WEMET assisted in a package interdiction in the 4500 block of Dowling. A quantity of LSD, Ecstasy, and ketamine was seized. It was determined the package was intended for Electric Forest attendees. An arrest was made on the investigation.

The Detective from WEMET assisted on a search warrant in the 100 block of Crescent. The detectives seized 2 loaded revolvers, 1 sawed-off shotgun, 3.7 grams of crack cocaine and 15 hydrocodone pills. The offender was lodged for possession of narcotics and felon in possession of firearms.

The Detective from WEMET assisted in the seizure of over 42 grams of heroin, 37 grams of crack cocaine, three firearms, and \$571.00 in cash during the month of June.

INTERNET CRIMES AGAINST CHILDREN (ICAC):

The Detective from ICAC conducted a phone examination for Muskegon Township Police Department reference a felonious assault complaint. Data was located and turn over to investigators.

The Detective from ICAC conducted a cellular phone examination and extraction for Muskegon County Sheriff’s Department on a Criminal Sexual Contact (CSC) investigation. Evidence was located and turned over to investigators.

The Detective from ICAC completed an investigation of Child Sexually Abuse Material (CSAM) that occurred in the 1900 block of Reneer. The detective located the material on snap chat account and determined that students from local high schools had created a factitious account and shared nude photographs of a Norton Shores resident. Charges have been filed for manufacture/deliver Child Sexually Abusive Material.
