
Class A type crimes (more serious) were down by 20% for the month and down by 14% for the fiscal year. Class B type crimes were up by 35% for the month and up by 11% for the fiscal year. Total crimes are down by 3% for the month and down by 5% for the fiscal year.

PATROL DIVISION HIGHLIGHTS

The Patrol Division responded to 1400 Windward on a vehicle that had been set on fire. Officers arrived to find a vehicle parked in the driveway and was partially on fire. With the help of the Norton Shores Fire Department the fire was extinguished. The officer observed the back of the vehicle was on fire at some point. There was a small fire on the grass but it was no longer lit. It appeared that there was gas inside a container and the container was now melted down and laying in the grass. The officer confirmed that there was gas poured onto the vehicle and set ablaze. The officer collected evidence for possible prints and DNA, photographed the scene and checked for video. The complaint still remains under investigation.

CALLS FOR SERVICE



During the month of October 2017, the Department recorded 1,392 Computer Aided Dispatch events, including 1,214 calls for service. A total of 789 written reports were generated during the month. The highest number of calls for service occurred on Monday.

Six officers including two command were sent to an eight hour Cultural Diversity class held at Grand Valley State University. This training informed and taught officers on how better to deal with minorities, diverse cultures, and the perception of police.

DETECTIVE BUREAU HIGHLIGHTS

During the month of October the Detective Bureau was assigned 15 new cases. Four cases were cleared by arrest, warrants, or other means. The remaining cases are still under investigation.

MAJOR ACTIVITIES

The Detective Bureau is currently investigating a stabbing and home invasion that occurred in the 200 block of Aue Rd. The victim was home alone when they heard a noise coming from the kitchen area of the home. When the victim went to the kitchen to investigate, she encountered a masked subject and an altercation ensued and the victim was stabbed. The masked subject fled on foot. An area check was conducted but the subject wasn't located. The detectives have been interviewing residents of the neighborhood, friends of the victim and investigating all possible leads. This is still an open investigation.

The Detective Bureau has investigated six criminal sexual conduct cases involving children this month. Each case is in various steps in the investigation from initial interviews to being reviewed by the prosecutor's office.

The Detective Bureau has investigated four child abuse cases. All four cases have been submitted to the prosecutor's office for review on charges.

The Detective Bureau signed a total of 24 arrest warrants this month which included warrants from the Patrol Division. Over 20 hours were spent at the Muskegon County Court building obtaining warrants, meeting with prosecutors, picking up and dropping off paperwork.

On October 12th, Detective Sergeant VanderStelt attended the child abuse case review.

On October 18th & 19th, Detective Swanker attended hostage negotiation training.

On October 25th, Detective Sergeant VanderStelt attended the Muskegon County Investigators meeting
