A meeting of the Norton Shores Election Commission was called to order on Monday, July 13, 2020 at 2:10 p.m., in the Norton Shores Municipal Building's small conference room.

Present: Commissioner Larsen and City Clerk Stibitz


Commissioner Larsen moved to approve the minutes of the April 30, 2020 Election Commission meeting. The motion was supported by Clerk Stibitz and carried unanimously.

Commissioner Larsen moved to approve the August 4, 2020 State primary ballots as presented. The motion was supported by Clerk Stibitz and carried unanimously.

Clerk Stibitz moved to appoint the list of Inspectors plus alternates to act as poll workers, Absentee Counting Boards and Receiving Boards in the conduct of the August 4, 2020 State Primary Election and authorize the Clerk or her designee to appoint additional inspectors or reassign inspectors before Election Day as necessary. The motion was supported by Commissioner Larsen and carried unanimously.

Commissioner Larsen moved to appoint the Clerk or her designee to prepare all necessary election materials for the August 4, 2020 State Primary Election and authorize the clerk or her designee to conduct the preliminary and public accuracy testing of all tabulators and voter assist terminals.
