A regular meeting of the Norton Shores City Council was held on Tuesday, March 7, 2023 at 5:30 p.m. at the Norton Shores Branch Library Community Room, 705 Seminole Road. Council Member Morgenstern delivered the invocation.

23-031 Minutes

Council Member Jurkas moved to approve minutes from the February 21 council meeting. The motion was supported by Council Member Olson and carried unanimously.

23-032 Council Member Flanders moved to approve minutes from the February 28 work session meeting. Council Member Sowa asked for clarification on where council left off with the special use permit revisions. Mayor Nelund stated that the consensus of council was to continue to discuss and have Mr. Hughes work on the proposed revisions that will first go to the Planning Commission. The motion was supported by Council Member Morgenstern and carried unanimously.

23-033 Consent

23-034 Adopt Zone Change – 2019 & 2123 W. Sherman Blvd., Bowyer and Goodwin

Council Member Morgenstern moved to adopt a zone change amendment to Chapter 48 to rezone 2019 and 2123 W. Sherman Blvd. from C-2 General Retail to Planned Unit Development. The motion was supported by Council Member Flanders and carried unanimously by roll call vote.

23-035 Award Bid – Vulcan Street Water Main

Council Member Moulatsiotis moved to award the contract for construction services for the Vulcan Watermain Replacement project to Dan's Excavating Service, Inc. of Grant, MI at a cost of \$301,036.00. The motion was supported by Council Member Sowa and carried unanimously.

23-036 MDNR Trust Fund Grant Application

Council Member Moulatsiotis moved to table the authorization of the grant submittal to the Michigan Department of Natural Resources Trust Fund until after the required public meeting is held on March 16, 2023 at 5:30pm in the Norton Shores Library Community Room. The motion was supported by Council Member Jurkas and carried unanimously.


General Public Comment
