A meeting of the Norton Shores Election Commission was called to order on Tuesday, March 15 2022 at 8:30 a.m., in the Norton Shores Municipal Building's Administrative Services conference room.

Present: Commissioners Broge, Larsen and City Clerk Stibitz

Commissioner Larsen moved to approve the minutes of the October 4, 2021 Election Commission meeting. The motion was supported by Commissioner Broge and carried unanimously.


Commissioner Broge moved to approve the May 3, 2022 Special Election ballots as presented. The motion was supported by Commissioner Larsen and carried unanimously.

Commissioner Larsen moved to appoint the list of Inspectors to act as poll workers, Absentee Counting Boards and Receiving Boards in the conduct of the May 3, 2022 Special Election and authorize the Clerk or her designee to appoint additional inspectors or reassign inspectors before Election Day as necessary. The motion was supported by Commissioner Broge and carried unanimously.

Commissioner Broge moved to appoint the City Clerk or her designee to prepare all necessary election materials for the May 3, 2022 Special Election and authorize the Clerk or her designee to conduct the preliminary and public accuracy testing of all tabulators and voter assist terminals. The motion was supported by Commissioner Larsen and carried unanimously.

Commissioner Broge moved to approve the precinct boundary lines as presented. The motion was supported by Commissioner Larsen and carried unanimously.
