22-147 Minutes

Council Member Sowa moved to approve the September 6 council minutes. The motion was supported by Council Member Olson and carried unanimously.

Consent

22-148 Council Member Moulatsiotis moved to approve the amended Consent Agenda which consisted of: a) Department Reports: 1. Police, 2. Fire, 3. Public Works, 4. Administrative Services, 5. Library and 6. Finance – 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter, b) Fireworks Permit – 3426 Getty Street, Steve Franklin and c) Intersection Permit – Kiwanis Club of Muskegon. The motion was supported by Council Member Jurkas and carried unanimously.

22-149 Land Division – 6126 Lake Harbor Road, Bohn Property

Council Member Moulatsiotis moved to grant permission to Jeff & Greg Bohn to divide the property at 6126 Lake Harbor Road to create (1) new parcel as per the submitted survey. The motion was supported by Council Member Kasher and carried unanimously.

22-150 Special Use Permit Amendment – 5057 Harvey Street, Target

Council Member Jurkas moved to approve a Special Use Permit Amendment to Kimley-Horn, an authorized agent of Target, for site improvements including: updated facade and signage, and a new pick-up structure within the existing parking lot. The motion was supported by Council Member Hylland and carried unanimously.

22-151 Bid Award – FY23 Water Service Materials

Council Member Moulatsiotis moved to award a contract for the FY-2023 Water Service Materials bid to Core & Main of Kentwood, MI, in the amount of

\$37,029.20 and authorizes the necessary mid-year adjustment. The motion was supported by Council Member Sowa and carried unanimously.

22-152 Sole Source Purchase – 6239 Grand Haven Road Wet Well Lining, Plummer’s Environmental

Council Member Morgenstern moved to approve the sole source purchase and installation of wet well lining at the 6239 Grand Haven Road de-watering lift station from Plummer’s Environmental Inc., of Byron Center, MI in the amount of \$29,200. The motion was supported by Council Member Kasher and carried unanimously.

22-153 Approve Installation – Street Light, Leif Avenue

Council Member Moulatsiotis moved to approve the installation of a streetlight on the existing power pole at the southeast corner of 2264 Leif Avenue. The motion was supported by Council Member Jurkas and carried unanimously.


General Public Comment
