The Project includes the following Work:

The project consists of hot-in-place recycling of existing pavement, appurtenances, and miscellaneous related items.

This project shall be coordinated to be performed simultaneously with a separate project, "2026 HMA Milling, Overlay, and Resurfacing" of the same roadways. It shall be the responsibility of the Contractors to coordinate their work on the other concurrent project.

Construction shall be in accordance with the Michigan Department of Transportation 2020 Standard Specifications for Construction. The project shall be completed by September 18, 2026.
