SUBJECT: June 2022 Information Update

1. Upcoming Summer Events in Norton Shores – The City is playing host to a number of fun events this summer. Following is a list from June through August:
 - Muskegon Care Affair/Wings of Mercy 5K Run – Muskegon County Airport, Saturday, June 11
 - Mona Lake Paddle Race – Ross Park, June 11
 - Stand Up for the Cure – Ross Park, July 9
 - AMA Hillclimb Grand Championship – Mount Garfield, August 12 – 14
 - Arts & Drafts Festival – Ross Park, August 20
2. Seminole Road Place Plan Phase II – Bids for the second phase of the Seminole Road Place Plan from Park Street to Seaway Drive will be let by MDOT the first week of July. This means that construction may start as soon as early August. The scope of work includes reconstruction of the roadway including concrete curb and gutter, bike lanes and sidewalks. Ornamental lighting will also be continued along the street with seventeen fixtures. The project timeline should be much shorter than Phase I as it does not include replacement of water and sanitary sewer infrastructure and it is about two-thirds of the distance. However, keep in mind that supply issues could impact the construction schedule.
3. Branding Banners – Staff is currently working on placing “It’s In Our Nature” banners along Seminole Road. If council recalls, staff recommended using the Henry Street Bridge banners for Seminole Road and purchasing new banners for the bridge that include larger logos to make them easier to read.
4. MML Annual Convention Save the Date – The Michigan Municipal League Annual Convention will be held in **Muskegon** October 19-21. Stay tuned for details.
