1. Audit Report

Finance Director Chris Lyonnais presented the highlights of the Fiscal Year 2025 annual audit and introduced Doug Vredeveld of Vredeveld Haefner LLC, CPAs and Consultants. Mr. Vredeveld reported that the audit contained no significant findings and confirmed the City is operating in full compliance with applicable governmental accounting standards and regulations.

2. Forest Park / Lake Harbor Trail

Director of Public Works Jim Murphy provided an update on the Forest Park Trail Project public meeting held October 29, 2025. He noted that residents did not express strong support for a multi-use path through the neighborhood but were more favorable toward a sidewalk option. Speed concerns were identified as their primary issue. Council reached consensus to continue the trail alignment north along Lake Harbor Road.
