1. Ross Park Pavilion Discussion – Anthony Chandler

City Administrator Anthony Chandler updated City Council on the status of the Ross Park Pavilion/Overlook Deck project. Media Coordinator Don Vanderkooi shared a 360-degree view of the pavilion, featuring a kitchenette, large overlook deck, and men and women's 3 stall bathrooms. The usage of the pavilion was discussed, along with suggestions for rates. Parks & Recreation Superintendent shared there will be a remote lock system in addition to 9 security cameras in place prior to becoming available to the public. Council Member Hylland was in favor of renting the pavilion as often as possible, and Council Member Sowa suggested adding a position to work with the public to schedule rentals.
