CITY COUNCIL WORK SESSION
June 25, 2024

A regular work session of the Norton Shores City Council was held at the Norton Shores Library, 705 Seminole Road, on Tuesday, June 25, 2024 at 5:35 p.m.

1. Building Permit Fee Update

Building Official Todd Kempf discussed the current fees for trades and building permits and presented options for fee adjustments to be considered by City Council. Mr. Kempf provided comparable fees from the State of Michigan and a neighboring community, as well as explained the difference between the current fee schedule and using the International Code Council's Building Evaluation Data to determine fees. The consensus was to have Mr. Kempf bring back more information, including the fee schedule of additional surrounding municipalities as well as sample pricing invoices.

2. Deer Management Program

City Administrator Anthony Chandler shared the success of the Deer Management Program from 2023 and stated the city would like to start preparing for the 2024 deer hunting season. Mr. Chandler reminded City Council that the DNR recommends conducting a managed deer hunt on a consistent annual basis for the program to remain successful.
