CITY COUNCIL MEETING  
March 6, 2018

A regular meeting of the Norton Shores City Council was held Tuesday, March 6, 2018 at 5:30 p.m. in the Community Room, Norton Shores Branch Library, 705 Seminole Road. Pastor Doug Vandermolen delivered the invocation.

18-024 Amend Agenda

Council Member Morgenstern moved to add Item 8d Fireworks Display Application – Bob Scolnik, 4460 Cherrywood Court to the Consent Agenda. The motion was supported by Council Member Flanders and carried unanimously.

18-025 Minutes

Council Member Beecham moved to approve the minutes of the February 20, 2018 City Council meeting. Council Member Morgenstern asked that the vote for Item 18-023, Introduce Ordinance – Rental Property, Rental Inspection Authorization be corrected to reflect Mayor Nelund’s no vote. The motion was supported by Council Member Flanders and the minutes were approved unanimously as amended.

18-026 Council Member Beecham moved to approve the minutes of the February 27, 2018 work session meeting. The motion was supported by Council Member Sladick and carried unanimously.

18-027 Consent Agenda as Amended

Council Member Morgenstern moved to adopt the Consent Agenda consisting of a) Endorsement – Mona Lake Trail Plan; b) Authorize Bids – Ceiling Tile, City Hall; c) Authorize Bids – Street Materials; and d) Fireworks Display Application – Bob Scolnik, 4460 Cherrywood Court. The motion was supported by Council Member Moulatsiotis and carried unanimously.

18-028 Class C Liquor License Renewals

The City Clerk certified publishing of the public notice and a public hearing was held. There were no comments.

Council Member Moulatsiotis moved to approve renewal of Class C Liquor Licenses to Bella Maria's, Bob Hi Inn, Celebration Banquets, Chili's, Cricket's Pub, Logan's Roadhouse, MiBar, No More Sidelines, Norton Pines, Old Homestead, The Patio/Airline Bar, Red Robin and Verdoni's Banquet Facility. The motion was supported by Council Member Flanders and carried unanimously.

18-029 Adopt Ordinance Amendment – Rental Property, Rental Inspector Authorization

Council Member Beecham moved to adopt an amendment to the Code of Ordinances, Chapter 8, Article VI, Section 118 [7(e)] authorizing the Rental Inspector to issue municipal civil infraction violation notices and citations related to the enforcement of the Rental Property Ordinance. The motion was supported by Council Member Morgenstern and carried 7/1 on a roll call with Mayor Nelund against and Council Member Jurkas absent.

18-030 Bid Award – Forest Park Road Engineering

Council Member Cross moved to award a contract for engineering inspection and surveying services for the Forest Park Road Resurfacing Project between Lake Harbor Road and Stryker Drive to Westshore Consulting of Muskegon, MI for a cost of \$22,530. The motion was supported by Council Member Flanders and carried unanimously.


18-031 Bid Award – Forest Park Road Resurfacing

Council Member Cross moved to award a contract for the resurfacing of Forest Park Road from Lake Harbor Road to Stryker Drive to Asphalt Paving, Inc., of Muskegon, MI for the not to exceed cost of \$270,332.88. The motion was supported by Council Member Sladick and carried unanimously.

Comments: Mayor Nelund confirmed that there will be a quorum for the April 3, 2018 meeting.

City Administrator Mark Meyers informed City Council that a public meeting regarding the Mona Lake Trail Plan is scheduled for March 19<sup>th</sup> and authorization to apply for grants to fund this project will be included on the March 20<sup>th</sup> agenda.
