24-008 Minutes

Council Member Jurkas moved to approve minutes from the January 16 city council meeting. The motion was supported by Council Member Kasher and carried unanimously.

Council Member Moulatsiotis moved to approve minutes from the January 23 work session meeting. The motion was supported by Council Member Olson and carried unanimously.

24-009 Consent

Council Member Moulatsiotis moved to approve the Consent Agenda which consisted of Guidelines for the Poverty Exemptions. The motion was supported by Council Member Hylland and carried unanimously.

24-010 Zone Change Adoption – 4788 Grand Haven Road, Russell Christensen

Council Member Jurkas moved to adopt a zone change amendment to Chapter 48 of the City ordinance to rezone 4788 Grand Haven Road from C-2 General Retail to R-2 Single Family Residential. The motion was supported by Council Member Olson and carried unanimously by a roll call vote.

24-011 Contract Change Order – Ross Park Pavilion

Council Member Moulatsiotis moved to authorize the change order to the Muskegon Quality Builders contract for the Ross Park Pavilion Project to install a new water line in

the amount of \$30,000 and authorizes an amendment to the FY 2024 CIP with the additional funding coming from ARPA funds. The motion was supported by Council Member Fisher and carried with 6 votes in favor with Council Member Hylland abstaining due to conflict of interest.

General Public Comment

Council Member Hylland suggested the Black Lake Park signs be updated with our new branding.

Council Member Moulatsiotis if there are any plans yet to usage this summer for the Ross Park Pavilion. City Administrator Anthony Chandler stated this discussion will likely be held during February work session.

Council Member Moulatsiotis thanked Director of Public Works Jim Murphy for the update on the Lake Harbor Trail. Mr. Chandler informed City Council that updates will be shared with them as they are available.
