CITY COUNCIL MEETING
March 19, 2024

A regular meeting of the Norton Shores City Council was held on Tuesday, March 19, 2024 at 5:30 p.m. at the Norton Shores Branch Library Community Room, 705 Seminole Road.

24-021 Minutes

Council Member Jurkas moved to approve minutes from the March 5 city council meeting. The motion was supported by Council Member Sowa and carried unanimously with a correction that Moulatsiotis was absent during the March 5 meeting.

24-022 Consent

Council Member Moulatsiotis moved to approve the Consent Agenda which consisted of: a) City Department Reports, and b) Authorization to Bid Street Material. The motion was supported by Council Member Jurkas and carried unanimously.

24-023 Special Use Permit – 6524 Schamber Drive, Industrial Inspection & Consulting LLC

Council Member Moulatsiotis moved to approve the special land use application to Industrial Inspection & Consulting LLC, to use a tenant space at 6524 Schamber Drive for industrial materials testing and laboratory facility. The motion was supported by Council Member Hylland and carried unanimously.

24-024 Authorize Purchase – Sole Source Flock Safety ALPR Cameras

Council Member Fisher moved to approve the authorization of the purchase of the ten Flock Safety ALPR cameras, in the amount of \$36,500 for FY 2024, and also approves a two-year agreement totaling \$66,500. The motion was supported by Council Member Moulatsiotis and carried unanimously.

Jim Hopper, 3869 Fairway Drive, stated his appreciation for the Norton Shores newsletter and remarked on its improved quality.

Holly Pelkey, Lead Librarian from the Norton Shores Library, shared past and upcoming events. 24-025 Closed Session – Discussion of Collective Bargaining Parameters

Council Member Jurkas moved to go into closed session to discuss collective bargaining parameters. The Motion was supported by Council Member Fisher and carried 6/1 with Council Member Moulatsiotis against. The regular City Council meeting resumed at 6:37 p.m.
