24-026 Minutes

Council Member Moulatsiotis moved to approve minutes from the March 19 city council meeting. The motion was supported by Council Member Jurkas and carried unanimously with a correction that section 24-024 was carried unanimously in its motion.

Council Member Morgenstern moved to approve minutes from the March 26 work session meeting. The motion was supported by Council Member Kasher and carried unanimously.

24-027 Consent

Council Member Fisher moved to approve the Consent Agenda which consisted of: a) Liquor License for Arts and Drafts Festival. The motion was supported by Council Member Moulatsiotis and carried unanimously.

24-029 Amend-PFAS Contract – Jackson-Merkey Contractors

Council Member Jurkas moved to approve the authorization of the amendment to the Jackson-Merkey Contractors contract for the PFAS Part 201 State Grant Funded project in

the amount up to \$476,354 and authorizing the adjustment to the current FY 2024 budget and the proposed FY 2025 budget. The motion was supported by Council Member Fisher and carried unanimously.

24-030 Approve – Rental Agreement – Ross Park Outlook Deck

Council Member Jurkas moved to approve the rental agreement for the Ross Park Outlook Deck with the proposed fee schedule. The motion was supported by Council Member Morgenstern and carried unanimously.
