Present: Commissioners Durnell, Larsen and City Clerk Stibitz



Commissioner Larsen moved to appoint the listed Chairpersons and Inspectors for precincts 1 – 10 as listed and authorize the City Clerk or her designee to make changes to the list in order to fill vacancies. The motion was supported by Commissioner Durnell and carried unanimously.

Commissioner Durnell moved to appoint the City Clerk or her designee to prepare all necessary election materials for the November 5, 2019 General Election and authorize the City Clerk or her designee to conduct all preliminary and public accuracy testing of tabulators and voter assist terminals. The motion was supported by Commissioner Larsen and carried unanimously.
