ELECTION COMMISSION MEETING  
February 13, 2020

A regular meeting of the Norton Shores Election Commission was called to order on Thursday, February 13, 2020 at 11:00 a.m. at the Municipal Building, 4814 Henry Street.

Present: Commissioner Larsen and City Clerk Stibitz

Absent: Commissioner Durnell

Commissioner Larsen moved to approve the minutes of the October 8, 2019 Election Commission meeting. The motion was supported by Clerk Stibitz and carried unanimously.

Commissioner Larson moved to approve the March 10, 2020 Presidential Primary ballot as presented. The motion was supported by Clerk Stibitz and carried unanimously.

Clerk Stibitz moved to appoint the revised list of Chairpersons and Inspectors for precincts 1 – 10 and authorize the City Clerk or her designee to make changes to the list in order to fill vacancies. The motion was supported by Commissioner Larsen and carried unanimously.

Commissioner Larsen moved to appoint the City Clerk or her designee to prepare all necessary election materials for the March 10, 2020 Presidential Primary Election and authorize the City Clerk or her designee to conduct all preliminary and public accuracy testing of tabulators and voter assist terminals. The motion was supported by Clerk Stibitz and carried unanimously.
