SUBJECT: Class C Liquor License Renewal

The Building, Fire and Police Departments have conducted inspection of Class C Liquor License establishments in Norton Shores and recommended approval of all businesses that currently have active licenses.

The Finance Department reviewed tax liability for all thirteen establishments and reported that one local business is delinquent. Logan's Roadhouse, 5601 Harvey Street, has outstanding real and personal property winter taxes. They did renew their Business Registration in February and messages were left with the contacts listed on their registration to call me and discuss the matter.

This restaurant has been completely closed during the pandemic and we've been told they may not reopen to the public when restrictions are lifted. At this time, I am including Logan's Roadhouse in the resolution as recommendation pending compliance.
