

Class A type crimes (more serious) were down 10% for the month compared to the same month last year and down 22% for FY2020. Class B type crimes were up by 4% for the month and down 19% for the FY2020. Total crimes were down 5% for the month and 21% for the FY2020.



CALLS FOR SERVICE



During the month of December 2019, the Department recorded 1,754 Computer Aided Dispatch events, including 1,157 calls for service. A total of 713 written reports were generated during the month. The highest number of calls for service occurred on Fridays.

TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT DATA

Department personnel issued 2 parking tickets and 191 traffic citations in December (see attached), which includes those issued as the result of crash investigations. Citations were issued in 57.8% of the traffic crashes that occurred this month.

**PATROL DIVISION HIGHLIGHTS**

Patrol Division responded to twenty-four retail fraud complaints during December. Eighteen cases resulted in arrest warrants for the offender. The other incidents the subject was not identified or the victim did not want to press charges.

Patrol Division investigated nine fraud complaints. The majority of the reports were related to online or phone scams.

Patrol Division responded to twenty-six complaints that involved individuals that had mental issues or were suicidal. The reports came from different areas of the city, which required two officers to respond. The officers assisted the people by getting them help through Health West or the Mobile Crises Team. Other times the officers transported the individual to the Community Mental Health hospital.

During December, the Patrol Division investigated twenty assault complaints. Fifteen cases were cleared by arrest, warrants, or other means. Five cases remain under investigation.

Patrol Division responded to ten larceny complaints. The majority of the complaints were unlocked vehicles entered during the overnight hours.

Over eight businesses were broken into during December. The majority of the incidents are still under investigation.

The total cruiser mileage for December 2019 was 26,865 miles.

### **TRAINING**

Because of Holidays and vacations, there was minimal training scheduled for December. On December 12, the Emergency Response Team conducted their monthly training.

### **DETECTIVE BUREAU HIGHLIGHTS**

During December, the Detective Bureau investigated eight new cases. Five cases have been closed. One case remains open awaiting an interview at the Child advocacy Center. The second remains open while monitoring jail calls, and the third awaits autopsy results. Detectives continue to work on other assigned cases as well.

### **NOTABLE ACTIVITIES**

The Detective Bureau made an arrest for the fatal hit & run which occurred Nov 24 on Seaway near Norton. Numerous search warrants were executed and interviews conducted. The vehicle used in the accident has been impounded and examined by the MSP crime lab.

### **WARRANTS**

The Detective Bureau signed a total of 39 arrest warrants this month, which included warrants from the Patrol Division. Over 30 hours were spent at the Muskegon County Court building, obtaining warrants, meeting with prosecutors, picking up and dropping off paperwork.

**WEST MICHIGAN ENFORCEMENT TEAM (WEMET)**

The Detective from WEMET conducted one purchase of narcotics in the city of Norton Shores. This resulted in one arrest and the seizure of 2.1 grams of crack cocaine.

The Detective from WEMET assisted in the execution of three search warrants in the greater Muskegon area which, along several purchases and traffic stops, resulted in the total seizure of 7.6 grams of crack cocaine, 25 grams of heroin, 4.4 grams of cocaine, and 800 grams of methamphetamine. A total of eight arrests were made.
