

Class A type crimes (more serious) were down 16% for the month compared to the same month last year and down 16% for FY2020. Class B type crimes were down by 7% for the month and down 20% for the FY2020. Total crimes were down by 12% for the month and down by 17% for the FY2020.



CALLS FOR SERVICE



During the month of March 2020, the Department recorded 1,729 Computer Aided Dispatch events, including 905 calls for service. A total of 474 written reports were generated during the month. The highest number of calls for service occurred on Mondays.

TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT DATA

Department personnel issued 1 parking ticket and 102 traffic citations in March (see attached), which includes those issued as the result of crash investigations. Citations were issued in 60% of the traffic crashes that occurred this month.

PATROL DIVISION HIGHLIGHTS

Patrol Division responded to twenty-three retail fraud complaints during March. Seventeen cases resulted in arrest warrants for the offender. In other incidents, the subject was not identified, or the victim did not want to press charges.

Patrol Division investigated eight fraud and counterfeiting complaints. The majority of the reports were related to online or phone scams.

Patrol Division responded to nineteen complaints that involved individuals that had mental issues or were suicidal. The reports came from different areas of the city, which required two officers to respond. The officers assisted the people by getting them help through Health West or the Mobile Crises Team. Other times the officers transported the individual to the Community Mental Health hospital.

During March, the Patrol Division investigated thirteen assault complaints. Ten cases were cleared by arrest, warrants, or other means. One case remains under investigation.

Patrol Division responded to five larceny complaints, a significant decrease from last month’s reports. There were three buildings entered overnight, and two vehicles entered.

The total cruiser millage for March 2020 was 25,986 miles.

Patrol Division Commander

The majority of out of office meetings attended by the Patrol Commander were canceled. Several meetings occurred with other city staff members to discuss the city’s planning for COVID-19.

TRAINING

One supervisor attended two days of advance supervisor training. Two officers attended a three-day course of forensic interviewing, where they learned the proper techniques to interview children and vulnerable adults. One officer attended background investigation training. The training provided the officer information on how to properly conduct a background investigation on potential new hires at the police department.

DETECTIVE BUREAU HIGHLIGHTS

During March 2020, the Detective Bureau investigated 14 new cases with eight being closed. Eight cases are currently under investigation.

NOTABLE ACTIVITY

In late March a business B&E had occurred and the DB was able to identify the offender via video surveillance. Further investigation resulted in connecting the offender to numerous B&Es that have occurred this year. The offender was ultimately arrested and charged with several B&Es. NSPD Detectives are cooperating with area agencies to tie this individual to B&Es within the west Michigan area.

WARRANTS

The Detective Bureau signed a total of 54 arrest warrants this month, which included warrants from the Patrol Division. Halfway through March the County Building was shut down due to COVID-19. Detectives are still tasked with picking up paperwork and signing warrants, however now must go into the jail.

WEST MICHIGAN ENFORCEMENT TEAM (WEMET)

The Detective from WEMET conducted two undercover buys within the city of Norton Shores. One gram of crack cocaine and 2.3 grams of meth was seized.

The Detective from WEMET assisted in the execution of three search warrants in the greater Muskegon area which, along several purchases of drugs and traffic stops, resulted in the total seizure of 68 grams of Methamphetamine, 18 grams of crack cocaine, 3 grams of heroin, and 5 grams of cocaine. A total of 9 arrests were made.

PROBLEM ORIENTED INTELLIGENCE-LED NEIGHBORHOOD TEAM (P.O.I.N.T.)
