



Class A type crimes (more serious) were down 31% for the month compared to the same month last year and down 18% for FY2020. Class B type crimes were down by 15% for the month and down 18% for the FY2020. Total crimes were down by 25% for the month and down by 18% for the FY2020.



CALLS FOR SERVICE



During the month of May 2020, the Department recorded 1,253 Computer Aided Dispatch events, including 1,082 calls for service. A total of 605 written reports were generated during the month. The highest number of calls for service occurred on Fridays.

TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT DATA

Department personnel issued 8 parking ticket and 76 traffic citations in May (see attached), which includes those issued as the result of crash investigations. Citations were issued in 45.45% of the traffic crashes that occurred this month.

PATROL DIVISION HIGHLIGHTS

Patrol Division responded to six retail fraud complaints during May, a significant decrease from the twenty-one reports in April. Three cases were closed by an arrest warrant for the offender. In other incidents, the subject was not identified, or the victim did not want to press charges.

Patrol Division investigated five fraud and counterfeiting complaints. The majority of the reports were related to online or phone scams.

Patrol Division responded to eighteen complaints that involved individuals that had mental issues or were suicidal. The reports came from different areas of the city, which required two officers to respond. The officers assisted the people by getting them help through Health West or the Mobile Crises Team. Other times the officers transported the individual to the Community Mental Health hospital.

Assault reports totaled twelve for May. Ten cases were cleared by arrest, warrants, or other means. Two cases remain under investigation.

Patrol Division responded to fifteen larceny complaints. Six vehicles were entered overnight. Four catalytic converters were stolen from commercial vehicles.

The total cruiser millage for May 2020 was 26,831 miles.

TRAINING

All in-person trainings were canceled. Several officers attended online training in various disciplines, including legal update.

DETECTIVE BUREAU HIGHLIGHTS

During May 2020, the Detective Bureau investigated 18 new cases with nine being closed. 12 cases are currently under investigation.

NOTABLE ACTIVITY

A detective followed up on a CSC report originally taken by a patrol officer. After additional interviews with the victim contact was made with the offender. The male, a resident of Louisiana, was staying at a local hotel while in town for construction work. The male was lodged on a charge of CSC.

WARRANTS

The Detective Bureau signed a total of 20 arrest warrants this month, which included warrants from the Patrol Division. The county building has been shut down the entire month due to COVID-19. Detectives are still tasked with picking up paperwork and signing warrants, however now must go into the jail.

WEST MICHIGAN ENFORCEMENT TEAM (WEMET)

Over the last several months WEMET has assisted the DEA and SWET, the South West Enforcement Team, with a wire case involving a NS resident. On Wednesday, 5/20/19, the offender was taken into federal custody. After arrest WEMET and DEA executed a search warrant of residence, on W Norton Ave in the City of Norton Shores. A firearm and a large quantity of suboxone strips were seized from the residence.

The offender is being federally charged with conspiracy to distribute and possess with intent to distribute 50 grams or more of methamphetamine, 500 grams or more of cocaine, and a quantity of heroin and quantity of suboxone. He was receiving large quantities of cocaine and methamphetamine directly from Mexico and distributing it in the Western District of Michigan.
