



CALLS FOR SERVICE



During the month of June 2020, the Department recorded 1,366 Computer Aided Dispatch events, including 1,338 calls for service. A total of 770 written reports were generated during the month. The highest number of calls for service occurred on Tuesdays.

TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT DATA

Department personnel issued 31 parking ticket and 56 traffic citations in June (see attached), which includes those issued as the result of crash investigations. Citations were issued in 41.6% of the traffic crashes that occurred this month.

PATROL DIVISION HIGHLIGHTS

Patrol Division responded to fifteen retail fraud complaints during June. Eleven cases were closed by an arrest warrant for the offender. In other incidents, the subject was not identified, or the victim did not want to press charges.

Patrol Division investigated six fraud and counterfeiting complaints. The majority of the reports were related to online or phone scams.

Patrol Division responded to twenty-six complaints that involved individuals that had mental issues or were suicidal. The reports came from different areas of the city, which required two officers to respond. The officers assisted the people by getting them help through Health West or the Mobile Crises Team. Other times the officers transported the individual to the Community Mental Health hospital, or ProMed transported the individual to Mercy Health Partners-Hackley Campus.

Assault reports totaled twenty-four for June, an increase of 100 percent from May. Twenty-two cases were cleared by arrest, warrants, or other means. Two cases remain under investigation.

Patrol Division responded to thirty-nine larceny complaints more than double the amount reported in May. Seventeen vehicles were entered overnight.

The total cruiser millage for June 2020 was 27,453 miles.

TRAINING

All road patrol shifts were provided training on how to use Zoom during a mental health call to connect the patient to a clinician quicker.

DETECTIVE BUREAU HIGHLIGHTS

During May 2020, the Detective Bureau investigated 21 new cases with 10 being closed. 11 cases are currently under investigation.

NOTABLE ACTIVITY

Road patrol contacted DB for assistance with a suspicious death case. The deceased had been found in a motel room completely covered with bedsheets. It was evident that someone had cleaned up the room and covered the deceased. Through an investigation utilizing the motel's video detectives found that another woman had left the room the day prior, paying for another night before leaving. This woman was identified and she admitted to concealing the death, which is likely due to a heroin overdose. Charges to be sought.

WARRANTS

The Detective Bureau signed a total of 37 arrest warrants this month, which included warrants from the Patrol Division. The county building has recently begun re-opening. Detectives are still tasked with picking up paperwork and signing warrants, however now must go into the jail.
