

Note- Year to date is the same as the monthly total this month due to July being the first month in the fiscal year.



CALLS FOR SERVICE



During the month of July 2020, the Department recorded 1,411 Computer Aided Dispatch events, including 1,401 calls for service. A total of 871 written reports were generated during the month. The highest number of calls for service occurred on Thursdays.

TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT DATA

Department personnel issued 24 parking tickets and 71 traffic citations in July (see attached), which includes those issued as the result of crash investigations. Citations were issued in 46.3% of the traffic crashes that occurred this month.

PATROL DIVISION HIGHLIGHTS

Patrol Division responded to eleven retail fraud complaints during July. Five cases were closed by an arrest warrant for the offender. In other incidents, the subject was not identified, or the victim did not want to press charges.

Patrol Division investigated five fraud and counterfeiting complaints. The majority of the reports were related to online or phone scams.

Patrol Division responded to thirty-eight complaints that involved individuals with mental issues or were suicidal, an increase of twelve complaints compared to June. The reports came from different areas of the city, which required two officers to respond. The officers assisted the people by getting them help through Health West or the Mobile Crises Team. Other times the officers transported the individual to the Community Mental Health hospital, or ProMed transported the individual to Mercy Health Partners-Hackley Campus.

Assault reports totaled eighteen for July. All the cases were cleared by arrest, warrants, or other means.

Patrol Division responded to twenty-one larceny complaints, which is eighteen less than June. Five vehicles were entered in July.

Patrol Division responded to five stolen vehicles this month. Four of the cars were recovered a short time after reporting them stolen. One vehicle remains outstanding.

The total cruiser mileage for July 2020 was 26,000 miles.

TRAINING

All members attended online Implicit Bias training. The training focused on presenting students with realistic and effective techniques that will assist in overcoming maladaptive bias, utilizing productive bias, and improving verbal and nonverbal communication skills immediately.

DETECTIVE BUREAU HIGHLIGHTS

During May 2020, the Detective Bureau investigated 24 new cases with 18 being closed. six cases are currently under investigation.

NOTABLE ACTIVITY

Det. Neher was assigned a case which involved an unknown person on Instagram soliciting nude videos/photos from a 11-year-old female. After an extensive investigation, and executing several search warrants Det Neher was able to determine that the offender was accessing the internet from an apartment in Comstock Park, MI.

On July 1, Det. Neher utilized the services of the MSP Computer Crimes Unit, Internet Crimes Against Children (ICAC) to execute a search warrant at the apartment. The offender confessed his crimes to Det Neher during an interrogation.

Det. Neher uncovered evidence of extensive Child Sexually Abusive Material (CSAM) manufactured. The suspect used a specific Instagram account to solicit CSAM from many juvenile females. A press release informed the public of this Instagram account and asked parents to check if their children had been contacted by the suspect. This resulted in several new victims being identified around the West Michigan area. The suspect is currently in the custody of the Muskegon County Jail and awaits trial.

WARRANTS

The Detective Bureau signed a total of 33 arrest warrants this month, which included warrants from the Patrol Division. The county building has recently begun re-opening. Detectives are still tasked with picking up paperwork and swearing to warrants on a daily basis.

WEST MICHIGAN ENFORCEMENT TEAM (WEMET)

The month of July was very active for WEMET. Highlights include a traffic stop/drug interdiction in Berrien County which resulted in the seizure of 18.3 pounds of Methamphetamine. Locally, a traffic stop in Muskegon Heights netted WEMET a kilogram of cocaine, a pistol, and \$3,400. The team made a total of 13 arrests and executed four search warrants.
