

Class A type crimes (more serious) were down 8% for the month compared to the same month last year and down 11% for the year. Class B type crimes were up by 16% for the month and up 22% for the year. Total crimes were up by 2% for the month and year.

CALLS FOR SERVICE



During the month of August 2020, the Department recorded 1,390 Computer Aided Dispatch events which is down from last month's total of 1,411, including 1,293 calls for service. A total of 853 written reports were generated during the month. The highest number of calls for service occurred on Saturday.

TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT DATA

Department personnel issued 30 parking tickets and 92 traffic citations in August (see attached), which includes those issued as the result of crash investigations. Citations were issued in 46.5% of the traffic crashes that occurred this month.

PATROL DIVISION HIGHLIGHTS

Patrol Division responded to eleven retail fraud complaints during August. Six cases were closed by arrest warrants for the offender. In other incidents, the subject was not identified, or the victim did not want to press charges.

Patrol Division investigated nine fraud and counterfeiting complaints. The majority of the reports were related to online or phone scams.

Patrol Division responded to 41 complaints that involved individuals with mental issues or were suicidal, an increase of 12 complaints compared to June. The reports came from different areas of the city, which required two officers to respond. The officers assisted the people by getting them help through Health West or the Mobile Crisis Team. Other times the officers transported the individual to the Community Mental Health hospital, or ProMed transported the individual to Mercy Health Partners-Hackley Campus.

Assault reports totaled 17 for August. All the cases were cleared by arrest, warrants, or other means.

Patrol Division responded to 21 larceny complaints. Six unlocked vehicles were entered in August.

Patrol Division responded to three stolen vehicles this month. All three cars were recovered a short time after reporting them stolen.

The total cruiser mileage for August 2020 was 27,430 miles.

TRAINING

No training occurred during the month of August.

DETECTIVE BUREAU HIGHLIGHTS

During August 2020, the Detective Bureau investigated 22 new cases with 14 being closed. Eight cases are currently under investigation.

NOTABLE ACTIVITY

As part of the Safe Senior Task Force, Det Morningstar has been investigating a large number of scams and frauds that elderly residents have fallen for. Recently an 81-year-old woman was found to have sent in excess of \$50,000 to her online millionaire boyfriend who had gotten trapped in Australia when his bank account was locked. She initially provided him with money to get home, however something always came up

which required more money. Her bank notified Adult Protective Services when she obtained an equity line of credit on her paid off home.

When detectives initially contacted the victim, she refused to believe that the relationship was not real. Eventually Det Morningstar was able to convince her that she had fallen victim to a “romance scam”. The investigation continues.

WARRANTS

The Detective Bureau signed a total of 34 arrest warrants this month, which included warrants from the Patrol Division. Detectives spend multiple hours per week at the county building swearing to warrants, picking up paperwork, and meeting with prosecutors.

WEST MICHIGAN ENFORCEMENT TEAM (WEMET)

During the month of August WEMET executed four search warrants and arrested nine offenders. Highlights include the seizure of 786 grams of methamphetamine and 57 grams of Heroin/Fentanyl. An illegal marijuana grow operation was shut down with the confiscation of 581 marijuana plants.
