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

Class A type crimes (more serious) were down 24% for the month compared to the same month last year and down 16% for FY2020. Class B type crimes were down by 3% for the month and down 18% for the FY2020. Total crimes were down by 16% for the month and down by 17% for the FY2020.



CALLS FOR SERVICE



During the month of April 2020, the Department recorded 1,584 Computer Aided Dispatch events, including 905 calls for service. A total of 476 written reports were generated during the month. The highest number of calls for service occurred on Thursdays.

TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT DATA

Department personnel issued 1 parking ticket and 27 traffic citations in April (see attached), which includes those issued as the result of crash investigations. Citations were issued in 52.9% of the traffic crashes that occurred this month.

PATROL DIVISION HIGHLIGHTS

Patrol Division responded to twenty-one retail fraud complaints during April two less than what was reported in March. Twelve cases resulted in arrest warrants for the offender. In other incidents, the subject was not identified, or the victim did not want to press charges.

Patrol Division investigated six fraud and counterfeiting complaints. The majority of the reports were related to online or phone scams.

Patrol Division responded to sixteen complaints that involved individuals that had mental issues or were suicidal three fewer reports than March. The reports came from different areas of the city, which required two officers to respond. The officers assisted the people by getting them help through Health West or the Mobile Crises Team. Other times the officers transported the individual to the Community Mental Health hospital.

Assault reports doubled in April for a total of twenty-three. Twenty-one cases were cleared by arrest, warrants, or other means. Two cases remain under investigation.

Patrol Division responded to nine larceny complaints. There were four buildings, and five vehicles entered overnight.

The total cruiser millage for March 2020 was 21,275 miles.

DETECTIVE BUREAU HIGHLIGHTS

During April 2020, the Detective Bureau investigated 15 new cases with nine being closed. Six cases are currently under investigation.

The Detective Bureau has been fortunate that during the month of April there were no major crimes which required investigative duties. This provided the detectives with opportunities to work on older cases.

WARRANTS

The Detective Bureau signed a total of 25 arrest warrants this month, which included warrants from the Patrol Division. The county building has been shut down the entire month due to COVID-19. Detectives are still tasked with picking up paperwork and signing warrants, however now must go into the jail.

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WEST MICHIGAN ENFORCEMENT TEAM (WEMET)

The Detective from WEMET investigated three suspected drug overdose deaths in the city of Norton Shores during the month of April.

The Detective from WEMET assisted in the execution of one search warrant in the greater Muskegon area which, along with several traffic stops, resulted in the total seizure of 13 grams of Methamphetamine and 15 grams of heroin. A total of seven arrests were made and two guns recovered.
