

Class A type crimes (more serious) were down 9% for the month compared to the same month last year and down 25% for FY2020. Class B type crimes were down by 21% for the month and down 18% for the FY2020. Total crimes were down 14% for the month and 22% for the FY2020.



CALLS FOR SERVICE



During the month of August 2019, the Department recorded 1,241 Computer Aided Dispatch events, including 1,627 calls for service. A total of 757 written reports were generated during the month. The highest number of calls for service occurred on Fridays.

TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT DATA

Department personnel issued 13 parking tickets and 240 traffic citations in August 2019, which includes those issued as the result of crash investigations. Citations were issued in 64.8% of the traffic crashes that occurred this month.

**PATROL DIVISION HIGHLIGHTS**

Patrol Division responded to twenty-one retail fraud complaints during August. Eleven cases resulted in arrest warrants for the offender. The other incidents the subject was not identified or the victim did not want to press charges.

Patrol Division investigated twenty-seven larceny complaints this month. Fifteen of the investigations were related to unlocked vehicles being entered overnight.

Patrol Division investigated nine fraud complaints. The majority of the reports were related to an online or phone scams.

Patrol Division responded to twenty complaints that involved individuals that had mental issues or were suicidal. The reports that were called in came from different areas of the city, which required two officers to respond. The officers assisted the

people by getting them help through Health West or the Mobile Crises Team. Other times the officers transported the individual to the Community Mental Health hospital.

During August, the Patrol Division investigated sixteen assault complaints. Fourteen cases were cleared by arrest, warrants, or other means. The remaining case is still under investigation.

Total cruiser millage for August 2019 was 30,132 miles.

On August 21, Lieutenant VanderStelt attended the monthly West Michigan Criminal Justice Training Consortium meeting.

On August 26, Lieutenant VanderStelt attended a meeting with Mona Shores High School and other community leaders for the planning of Sailor Salute.

On August 27, Lieutenant VanderStelt attended a meeting with the area command staff on the development of a regional field force team.

#### **TRAINING**

The entire department received firearms training.

Three officers attended two days of training for speed enforcement.

#### **DETECTIVE BUREAU HIGHLIGHTS**

During August, the Detective Bureau investigated nine new cases. Three cases were cleared by arrest, warrants, or other means. The remaining cases are still under investigation.

#### **MAJOR ACTIVITIES**

The Detective Bureau investigated an assault case in the 1200 block of East Broadway where the victim was run over by a vehicle. The victim is in a medically induced coma, and the driver of the vehicle is currently in jail. The investigation is turned over to the Muskegon County Prosecutor's office for review.

The Detective Bureau spent a week with the Muskegon County Prosecutor's office preparing for trial related to a 2018 homicide.

The Detective Bureau signed a total of 38 arrest warrants this month which included warrants from the Patrol Division. Over 25 hours were spent at the Muskegon County Court building obtaining warrants, meeting with prosecutors, picking up and dropping off paperwork.

On August 7, Detective Morningstar attended vulnerable adult abuse case review.

On August 20 – 22, Detective Morningstar and Detective Pieske attended a three-day training on financial crimes.

On August 28, Detective Swanker and Detective Pieske attended the monthly Muskegon County investigators meeting.

#### **WEST MICHIGAN ENFORCEMENT TEAM (WEMET)**

The Detective from WEMET conducted a traffic stop on US31 and Pontaluna. The detective seized 7 grams of crack cocaine, 1 gram of heroin, 18 grams of meth, and \$300.00 in cash. The driver of the vehicle was arrested for the possession of narcotics.

The Detective from WEMET assisted in a search warrant in the 2100 block of Valley Street in Muskegon. Detectives seized 1.5 grams of crack cocaine, 32 grams of meth, and \$3,745.00 in cash.

The Detective from WEMET investigated heroin overdoses in the city of Norton Shores during August.

The Detective from WEMET assisted in the seizure of over 4 grams of heroin, 14 grams of crack cocaine, and 100 grams of meth during August.
