

Class A type crimes (more serious) were down 2% for the month compared to the same month last year and down 16% for FY2020. Class B type crimes were down by 18% for the month and down 20% for the FY2020. Total crimes were down by 8% for the month and down by 18% for the FY2020.

CALLS FOR SERVICE



During the month of February 2020, the Department recorded 1,726 Computer Aided Dispatch events, including 877 calls for service. A total of 586 written reports were generated during the month. The highest number of calls for service occurred on Fridays.

TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT DATA

Department personnel issued 4 parking ticket and 294 traffic citations in February (see attached), which includes those issued as the result of crash investigations. Citations were issued in 63.7% of the traffic crashes that occurred this month.

PATROL DIVISION HIGHLIGHTS

Patrol Division responded to fifteen retail fraud complaints during February. Eight cases resulted in arrest warrants for the offender. In other incidents, the subject was not identified, or the victim did not want to press charges.

Patrol Division investigated ten fraud and counterfeiting complaints. The majority of the reports were related to online or phone scams.

Patrol Division responded to twenty-five complaints that involved individuals that had mental issues or were suicidal. The reports came from different areas of the city, which required two officers to respond. The officers assisted the people by getting them help

through Health West or the Mobile Crises Team. Other times the officers transported the individual to the Community Mental Health hospital.

During February, the Patrol Division investigated seventeen assault complaints. Sixteen cases were cleared by arrest, warrants, or other means. One case remains under investigation.

Patrol Division responded to thirteen larceny complaints, a significant decrease from last month's reports. The majority of the complaints were unlocked vehicles entered during the overnight hours.

The total cruiser millage for February 2020 was 23,738 miles.

TRAINING

There were over 210 hours of training attended in February. Two officers traveled to Alabama for field force training provided by FEMA. One officer spent a week in Lansing learning the TEAM (Teaching, Educating, and And Mentoring) program. Three detectives attended a one day class about vulnerable adult investigations, and the ERT members took their driving test for all assigned vehicles.

DETECTIVE BUREAU HIGHLIGHTS

During February 2020, the Detective Bureau investigated 10 new cases with 9 being closed. One case remains open awaiting autopsy results.

WARRANTS

The Detective Bureau signed a total of 42 arrest warrants this month, which included warrants from the Patrol Division. Over 35 hours were spent at the Muskegon County Court building, obtaining warrants, meeting with prosecutors, picking up, and dropping off paperwork.

WEST MICHIGAN ENFORCEMENT TEAM (WEMET)

The Detective from WEMET conducted one undercover buy within the city of Norton Shores. 4.1 grams of meth was seized. One traffic stop in Norton Shores resulted in the arrest of three subjects.

The Detective from WEMET assisted in the execution of five search warrants in the greater Muskegon area which, along several purchases and traffic stops, resulted in the total seizure of an outstanding 6,967 grams of Methamphetamine. An assortment of other drugs, such as: Cocaine, heroin, and crack was also seized. A total of 4 arrests were made along with the seizure of 2 firearms.
