

Class A type crimes (more serious) were up 33% for the month compared to the same month last year and down 17% for FY2020. Class B type crimes were down by 29% for the month and down 20% for the FY2020. Total crimes were up by 4% for the month and down by 18% for the FY2020.

CALLS FOR SERVICE



During the month of January 2020, the Department recorded 2,103 Computer Aided Dispatch events, including 978 calls for service. A total of 736 written reports were generated during the month. The highest number of calls for service occurred on Fridays.

TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT DATA

Department personnel issued 1 parking ticket and 219 traffic citations in January (see attached), which includes those issued as the result of crash investigations. Citations were issued in 63.6% of the traffic crashes that occurred this month.

PATROL DIVISION HIGHLIGHTS

Patrol Division responded to ten retail fraud complaints during January. Eight cases resulted in arrest warrants for the offender. In other incidents the subject was not identified, or the victim did not want to press charges.

Patrol Division investigated ten fraud complaints. The majority of the reports were related to online or phone scams.

Patrol Division responded to twenty-six complaints that involved individuals that had mental issues or were suicidal. The reports came from different areas of the city, which required two officers to respond. The officers assisted the people by getting them help through Health West or the Mobile Crises Team. Other times the officers transported the individual to the Community Mental Health hospital.

During January, the Patrol Division investigated sixteen assault complaints. Fifteen cases were cleared by arrest, warrants, or other means. One case remains under investigation.

Patrol Division responded to twenty-six larceny complaints. The majority of the complaints were unlocked vehicles entered during the overnight hours.

The total cruiser millage for January 2020 was 28,071 miles.

PATROL DIVISION COMMANDER

On January 15, Lieutenant VanderStelt attended the West Michigan Training Consortium meeting in Holland, MI.

On January 16, Lieutenant VanderStelt attended State of Michigan accreditation training in Lansing, MI.

TRAINING

There were over 160 hours of training conducted in January. The training consisted of leadership, emergency response, forfeiture, legal justification, and situational awareness training.

DETECTIVE BUREAU HIGHLIGHTS

During January, the Detective Bureau investigated 13 new cases with 11 being closed. One case remains open awaiting an interview at the CAC; the second is under additional investigation before submitting for a warrant.

NOTABLE ACTIVITIES

The Detective Bureau investigated an armed Robbery of Ozzie's Party store which occurred on Jan 13. The offender was identified, located, interviewed, and arrested within 24 hours.

WARRANTS

The Detective Bureau signed a total of 31 arrest warrants this month, which included warrants from the Patrol Division. Over 25 hours were spent at the Muskegon County Court building, obtaining warrants, meeting with prosecutors, picking up, and dropping off paperwork.

WEST MICHIGAN ENFORCEMENT TEAM (WEMET)

The Detective from WEMET conducted two undercover buys within the city of Norton Shores. 9 g Meth, 5.5 g BHO, and 8 g Marijuana was seized along with one arrest.

The Detective from WEMET assisted in the execution of six search warrants in the greater Muskegon area which, along several purchases and traffic stops, resulted in the total seizure of 86 grams of crack cocaine, 43 grams of heroin, 139 grams of cocaine, and 64 grams of methamphetamine. A total of 12 arrests were made along with the seizure of six firearms.
