## ADMINISTRATION



Class A type crimes (more serious) were down 10% for the month compared to the same month last year and down 24% for FY2020. Class B type crimes were down by 21% for the month and down 22% for the FY2020. Total crimes were down 13% for the month and 23% for the FY2020.

CALLS FOR SERVICE



During the month of November 2019, the Department recorded 1,553 Computer Aided Dispatch events, including 1,021 calls for service. A total of 686 written reports were generated during the month. The highest number of calls for service occurred on Friday.

TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT DATA

Department personnel issued 0 parking tickets and 156 traffic citations in November (see attached), which includes those issued as the result of crash investigations. Citations were issued in 58% of the traffic crashes that occurred this month.

**PATROL DIVISION HIGHLIGHTS**

Patrol Division responded to sixteen retail fraud complaints during November. Eleven cases resulted in arrest warrants for the offender. The other incidents the subject was not identified or the victim did not want to press charges.

Patrol Division investigated five fraud complaints. The majority of the reports were related to online or phone scams.

Patrol Division responded to twenty-two complaints that involved individuals that had mental issues or were suicidal. The reports that were called in came from different areas of the city, which required two officers to respond. The officers assisted the people by getting them help through Health West or the Mobile Crises Team. Other times the officers transported the individual to the Community Mental Health Hospital.

During November, the Patrol Division investigated twenty-one assault complaints. All of the cases were cleared by arrest, warrants, or other means.

Total cruiser millage for November 2019 was 21,463 miles.

On November 4, Lieutenant VanderStelt attended a meeting with the Metro Field Force committee in Kent County.

On November 6, Lieutenant VanderStelt attended four-hour training at Baker College Muskegon on the stress and trauma for first responders.

On November 20, Lieutenant VanderStelt attended the West Michigan Criminal Justice Training Consortium (WMCJTC) monthly curriculum meeting in Zeeland, MI.

On November 21, Lieutenant VanderStelt attended the WMCJTC Field Training Officers subcommittee meeting in Holland, MI.

**TRAINING**

On November 5 and 7, the department held its annual use of force training. Officers reviewed the use of force policy and were tested on their proper use of de-escalation tactics, less lethal, and lethal weapons.

On November 12 and 13, one supervisor attended advanced Incident Command Systems (ICS) training in Ottawa County.

**DETECTIVE BUREAU HIGHLIGHTS**

During November, the Detective Bureau investigated nine new cases. Seven cases were cleared by arrest, warrants, or other means. Two cases remain under active investigation.

**NOTABLE ACTIVITIES**

A fatal pedestrian hit & run occurred during the early hours of Sunday, November 24 on Seaway between Norton and Seminole. This incident remains under investigation as detectives pursue avenues to identify the offending vehicle.

**WARRANTS**

The Detective Bureau signed a total of 31 arrest warrants this month, which included warrants from the Patrol Division. Over 30 hours were spent at the Muskegon County Court building, obtaining warrants, meeting with prosecutors, picking up, and dropping off paperwork.

**WEST MICHIGAN ENFORCEMENT TEAM (WEMET)**

The Detective from WEMET conducted one purchase of narcotics in Norton Shores. This resulted in one arrest and the seizure of 2.9 grams of crack and .9 gram of cocaine. One subject with a warrant for Open Murder was arrested in Norton Shores and lodged at the Muskegon County Jail.

The Detective from WEMET assisted in the execution of two search warrants in the greater Muskegon area which, along with several purchases and traffic stops, resulted in the total seizure of 15.1 grams of crack cocaine, 40 grams of heroin, 2.5 grams of cocaine, 100 grams of MDMA, and 207 grams of methamphetamine. Also seized was \$4,000. A total of ten arrests were made.
