



Class A type crimes (more serious) were down 36% for the month compared to the same month last year and down 26% for FY2020. Class B type crimes were down by 7% for the month and down 22% for the FY2020. Total crimes were down 21% for the month and 25% for the FY2020.

CALLS FOR SERVICE



During the month of October 2019, the Department recorded 1,553 Computer Aided Dispatch events, including 1,157 calls for service. A total of 728 written reports were generated during the month. The highest number of calls for service occurred on Fridays.

TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT DATA

Department personnel issued 1 parking ticket and 232 traffic citations in October (see attached), which includes those issued as the result of crash investigations. Citations were issued in 33% of the traffic crashes that occurred this month.

PATROL DIVISION HIGHLIGHTS

Patrol Division responded to twenty-two retail fraud complaints during October. Twelve cases resulted in arrest warrants for the offender. The other incidents the subject was not identified or the victim did not want to press charges.

Patrol Division investigated eight fraud complaints. The majority of the reports were related to online or phone scams.

Patrol Division responded to sixteen complaints that involved individuals that had mental issues or were suicidal. The reports that were called in came from different areas of the city, which required two officers to respond. The officers assisted the people by getting them help through Health West or the Mobile Crises Team. Other times the officers transported the individual to the Community Mental Health hospital.

During October, the Patrol Division investigated thirteen assault complaints. All of the cases were cleared by arrest, warrants, or other means. Total cruiser millage for October 2019 was 26,167 miles.

On October 4, Lieutenant VanderStelt attended the Grand Valley State University Police Academy advisor board meeting in Allendale, MI.

TRAINING

October was a very busy month for training for the police department with over 560 hours of training. Three command officers attended Incident command school. Two officers attended a two-day conference for hostage negotiation. One officer attended two of three scheduled weeks of advanced Drug Recognition Education (DRE) training. One officer attended Field Training Officer training for a week. The whole department was received eight hours of training on physical control tactics and qualified with all three of our firearm systems (pistol, rifle, and shotgun).

DETECTIVE BUREAU HIGHLIGHTS

During October, the Detective Bureau investigated nineteen new cases. Eight cases were cleared by arrest, warrants, or other means. Eleven cases remain under active investigation.

NOTABLE ACTIVITIES

The Detective Bureau investigated two business burglaries in which safes were either stolen or broken into. The suspect is believed to have committed over twenty business burglaries within Muskegon County. Multiple jurisdictions coordinated their investigations. The suspect committed suicide when stopped by MSP during an attempted arrest.

WARRANTS

The Detective Bureau signed a total of 46 arrest warrants this month, which included warrants from the Patrol Division. Over 25 hours were spent at the Muskegon County Court building, obtaining warrants, meeting with prosecutors, picking up, and dropping off paperwork.

WEST MICHIGAN ENFORCEMENT TEAM (WEMET)

The Detective from WEMET conducted several purchases of narcotics within the city of Norton Shores. 1 gram of cocaine and 3 grams of methamphetamine were seized.

The Detective from WEMET assisted in the execution of five search warrants in the greater Muskegon area which resulted in the total seizure of 71 grams of crack cocaine, 8 grams of heroin, 39 grams of cocaine, and 34 grams of methamphetamine. Also seized was one pistol and nearly \$10,000 cash.
