


CALLS FOR SERVICE



During the month of July 2019, the Department recorded 1,313 Computer Aided Dispatch events, including 1,591 calls for service. A total of 792 written reports were

generated during the month. The highest number of calls for service occurred on Mondays and Tuesdays.

TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT DATA

Department personnel issued 8 parking tickets and 205 traffic citations in July 2019, which includes those issued as the result of crash investigations. Citations were issued in 74.5% of the traffic crashes that occurred this month.

PATROL DIVISION HIGHLIGHTS

Patrol Division responded to twelve retail fraud complaints during July. Six cases resulted in arrest warrants for the offender. The other six incidents resulted in the subject not being identified or the victim did not want to press charges.

Patrol Division investigated ten fraud complaints. The majority of the reports were related to an online or phone scams.

Patrol Division responded to twenty-eight complaints that involved individuals that had mental issues or were suicidal. The reports that were called in came from different areas of the city, which required two officers to respond. The officers assisted the people by getting them help through Health West or the Mobile Crises Team. Other times the officers transported the individual to the Community Mental Health hospital.

During July, the Patrol Division investigated twenty-two assault complaints. Twenty-one cases were cleared by arrest, warrants, or other means. The remaining case is still under investigation.

Total cruiser millage for July 2019 was 27,476 miles.

On July 23, Lieutenant VanderStelt attended a meeting with the area command staff on the development of a regional field force team.

On July 29, Lieutenant VanderStelt attended a meeting with Mona Shores High School and other community leaders for the planning of Sailor Salute.

TRAINING

The entire department received firearms training.

One officer attended Inclusive Recruitment and Retention Conference.

Four officers attended Rescue Task Force training.

Four officers attended mental health awareness training.

Three officers attended breathalyzer (data master) certification training.

DETECTIVE BUREAU HIGHLIGHTS

During July, the Detective Bureau investigated eleven new cases. Four cases were cleared by arrest, warrants, or other means. The remaining cases are still under investigation.

MAJOR ACTIVITIES

The Detective Bureau investigated two bad check complaints where the suspects created checks in a company name and cashed them at a local bank. The investigation is turned over to the Muskegon County Prosecutor's office for review.

The Detective Bureau spent three days with the United States Attorney's Office and the FBI preparing for trial related to a 2016 homicide.

The Detective Bureau signed a total of 50 arrest warrants this month which included warrants from the Patrol Division. Over 30 hours were spent at the Muskegon County Court building obtaining warrants, meeting with prosecutors, picking up and dropping off paperwork.

On July 10, Detective Swanker and Detective Morningstar attended vulnerable adult abuse case review.

On July 16, Detective Swanker attended a vulnerable adult conference in Detroit, MI.

On July 31, Detective Morningstar attended the monthly Muskegon County investigators meeting.

WEST MICHIGAN ENFORCEMENT TEAM (WEMET)

On July 1, 2019, a member of the department was placed back in WEMET. During their first month of their new assignment, the Detective has been learning the computer system and evidence processing. The Detective was assigned several Silent Observer Tips of drug sale and use in Norton Shores. The Detective is investigating three drug overdoses that occurred in Norton Shores.

PROBLEM ORIENTED INTELLIGENCE-LED NEIGHBORHOOD TEAM (P.O.I.N.T.)

- On July 3rd, Sgt. Hibler provided mutual assistance to Whitehall PD regarding traffic safety.
- On July 9th, Sgt. Hibler began attending a three week seminar with various health and human service officials on coalition building and best practices.
- Also on July 9th, Ofc. Passchier gave a presentation to Service One Credit Union on safely dealing with robberies called *Safe Catch*.
- On July 10th, POINT Officers held *Cones & Cops* at Whippy Dip.
- Also on July 10th, Sgt. Hibler and Ofc. Trombley attended a Michigan Traffic Crash Data seminar in Lansing.

- On July 11th, Officers Trombley and Passchier taught a Civilian Response to Active Shooter Event (CRASE) course to employees at Knoll manufacturing.
- On July 12th, Ofc. Passchier attended a marketing seminar to further advance NSPD's *Ride with Pride* program.
- On July 16th, Ofc. Leach met with local residents in the E Summit Ave area concerning juvenile and traffic complaints.

TRAFFIC & MARINE COMPLAINT HIGHLIGHTS

- On July 8th, Ofc. Trombley held children car seat safety checks at Norton Shores Fire Station #3.
- On July 9th, Ofc. Trombley attended the monthly Traffic Incident Management meeting.
- On July 22nd, Ofc. Trombley held a second children car seat safety check at Muskegon Fire.
- Speed trailers and signs continue to be rotated around the city in an effort to deter speeding in residential areas
- POINT Officers have been conducting regular traffic enforcement targeting speeding, prohibited truck traffic, and intersection related issues through the city's residential neighborhoods.
- Beginning in July, POINT Officers began daily (weather dependent) marine patrol to address an increase in boating concerns on Mona Lake and along the 6 miles of Lake Michigan frontage. Citizen contacts are regularly made for safety issues and slow-no-wake violations.
