

Class A type crimes (more serious) were down 11% for the month and down 5% for the fiscal year. Class B type crimes were up by 17% for the month and up by 3% for the fiscal year. Total crimes were down 2% for the month and down by 2% for the fiscal year.

CALLS FOR SERVICE



During the month of March 2019, the Department recorded 2016 Computer Aided Dispatch events, including 1001 calls for service. A total of 584 written reports were generated during the month. The highest number of calls for service occurred on Friday.

TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT DATA

Department personnel issued 1 parking tickets and 310 traffic citations in March 2019, which includes those issued as the result of crash investigations. Citations were issued in 59.5% of the traffic crashes that occurred this month.

PATROL DIVISION HIGHLIGHTS

Patrol Division responded to 17 retail fraud complaints during the month of March. Twelve complaints resulted in arrest warrants for the offender.

Patrol Division investigated 18 fraud complaints during the month of March. The majority of the reports were related to online or phone scam.

Patrol Division responded to over 17 complaints that involved individuals that had mental issues or were suicidal. The complaints that were called in came from different areas of the city which required two officers to respond. The officers assisted the people by getting them help through Health West or the Mobile Crises Team. Other times the officers transported the individual to the Community Mental Health hospital.

Total cruiser millage for March 2019 was 26,548 miles.

Training

All sworn members of the department attended a legal update about the new marijuana laws.

Three command officers attended 24 hours of training on Incident Command structure.

DETECTIVE BUREAU HIGHLIGHTS

During the month of March, the Detective Bureau investigated fifteen new cases. Five cases were cleared by arrest, warrants or other means. The remaining cases are still under investigation.

MAJOR ACTIVITIES

The Detective Bureau investigated a Criminal Sexual Conduct case. Two juvenile victims were identified and disclosed a relative sexually assaulted them. The suspect refused an interview and charged with three counts of CSC. They are currently at the Muskegon County Jail awaiting trial.

The Detective Bureau is investigating burglary reports from A plus storage at 1725 W. Sherman. The Michigan State Police caught an offender and 100s of items of stolen property have been recovered. Detectives worked with MSP to identify the victim's property and return it to the rightful owner.

The Detective Bureau investigated two separate credit card frauds. It was determined the cards were stolen while the victims were at 801 W Norton Ave. The cards were then used at local convenience stores by the offenders. Charges are pending.

The Detective Bureau signed a total of 35 arrest warrants this month which included warrants from the Patrol Division. Over 30 hours were spent at the Muskegon County Court building obtaining warrants, meeting with prosecutors, picking up and dropping off paperwork.

On March 6, Lieutenant VanderStelt attended vulnerable adult abuse case review.

On March 7, Detective Swanker attended the quarterly child death review.

On March 27, Detectives Morningstar, Swanker, and Pieske attended the monthly Muskegon County investigators meeting.
