

Class A type crimes (more serious) were down 15% for the month and down 5% for the fiscal year. Class B type crimes were up by 4% for the month and up by 0.6% for the fiscal year. Total crimes were down 8% for the month and down by 3% for the fiscal year.

CALLS FOR SERVICE



During the month of May 2019, the Department recorded 1573 Computer Aided Dispatch events, including 1177 calls for service. A total of 791 written reports were generated during the month. The highest number of calls for service occurred on Friday.

TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT DATA

Department personnel issued 6 parking tickets and 232 traffic citations in May 2019, which includes those issued as the result of crash investigations. Citations were issued in 62% of the traffic crashes that occurred this month.

PATROL DIVISION HIGHLIGHTS

Patrol Division responded to eighteen retail fraud complaints during the month of May. Eleven complaints resulted in arrest warrants for the offender.

Patrol Division investigated seventeen fraud complaints. The majority of the reports were related to an online or phone scam.

Patrol Division responded to over twenty-four complaints that involved individuals that had mental issues or were suicidal. The reports that were called in came from different areas of the city, which required two officers to respond. The officers assisted the people by getting them help through Health West or the Mobile Crises Team. Other times the officers transported the individual to the Community Mental Health hospital.

Total cruiser millage for May 2019 was 27,537 miles.

On May 15, Lieutenant VanderStelt attended the West Michigan Criminal Justice Training Consortium annual curriculum and general membership meeting at GVSU.

On May 22, Lieutenant VanderStelt attended a meeting with Health West coordinators to discuss referral process improvements.

Training

The entire department received two hours of self-aid training, including tourniquet applications and administering Narcan.

Five officers attended a two-day Advanced Roadside Impaired Driving Enforcement (ARIDE), class. The course is designed to help officers become more proficient at detecting, apprehending, testing, and prosecuting impaired drivers.

Four command officers attended a week-long training of advanced SWAT training in Alpena, Michigan.

Two command officers attended two-day training on emerging legal and litigation trends for tactical response teams.

DETECTIVE BUREAU HIGHLIGHTS

During the month of May, the Detective Bureau investigated sixteen new cases. Nine cases were cleared by arrest, warrants or other means. The remaining cases are still under investigation.

MAJOR ACTIVITIES

The Detective Bureau investigated a Criminal Sexual Conduct case in the 1100 block of Seminole. A male subject was caught having sex with an underaged female. Charges are pending.

The Detective Bureau is investigating a security breach to the ATMs at a local credit union. Over two hundred victims have been identified. Investigators are working with the Secret Service after determining the infringement is an international criminal enterprise.

The Detective Bureau investigated a shooting in the 1300 block of East Broadway. A friend accidentally shot the victim. Evidence at the scene showed unregistered

weapons and narcotics. Lab results for the drugs and blood test results of the suspect are pending.

The Detective Bureau signed a total of 49 arrest warrants this month which included warrants from the Patrol Division. Over 30 hours were spent at the Muskegon County Court building obtaining warrants, meeting with prosecutors, picking up and dropping off paperwork.

On May 1, Detective Swanker and Morningstar attended vulnerable adult abuse case review.

On May 29, Detectives Morningstar, Swanker, and Pieske attended the monthly Muskegon County investigators meeting.
