





Class A type crimes (more serious) were down 24% for the month and down 6.5% for the fiscal year. Class B type crimes were down by 18% for the month and down by 1% for the fiscal year. Total crimes were down 21% for the month and down by 5% for the fiscal year.

CALLS FOR SERVICE



During the month of June 2019, the Department recorded 1,466 Computer Aided Dispatch events, including 1,131 calls for service. A total of 716 written reports were generated during the month. The highest number of calls for service occurred on Saturday.

TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT DATA

Department personnel issued 9 parking tickets and 243 traffic citations in June 2019, which includes those issued as the result of crash investigations. Citations were issued in 74.5% of the traffic crashes that occurred this month.

PATROL DIVISION HIGHLIGHTS

Patrol Division responded to thirteen retail fraud complaints during the month of June. Nine cases resulted in arrest warrants for the offender.

Patrol Division investigated fourteen fraud complaints. The majority of the reports were related to an online or phone scam.

Patrol Division responded to fourteen complaints that involved individuals that had mental issues or were suicidal. The reports that were called in came from different areas of the city, which required two officers to respond. The officers assisted the people by getting them help through Health West or the Mobile Crises Team. Other times the officers transported the individual to the Community Mental Health hospital.

During the month of June, the Patrol Division investigated twenty-one assault complaints. Nineteen cases were cleared by arrest, warrants, or other means. The remaining cases are still under investigation.

The patrol division investigated larceny of city water from the 900 block of Airport Rd. The offender admitted to bypassing the water meter. A warrant was issued for fraudulent use of a public utility.

Total cruiser mileage for June 2019 was 29,923 miles.

Two detectives attended three-day forensic fraud training in Ottawa County.

Four female officers attended one day of training titled "Female Enforcers."

Five officers attended one day of training titled "Bullet Proof Mind."

DETECTIVE BUREAU HIGHLIGHTS

During the month of June, the Detective Bureau investigated nine new cases. Five cases were cleared by arrest, warrants, or other means. The remaining cases are still under investigation.

MAJOR ACTIVITIES

The Detective Bureau investigated the embezzlement of a non-profit organization in the 1100 block of Seminole Road. The subject confessed to the fraud and was taken into custody after an arrested warrant was granted.

The Detective Bureau investigated a drive-by shooting in the 3500 block of Hiawatha Dr. It was determined that the shooting was not a random act. Investigators obtained a possible name of the shooter; however, since then the victim has refused to cooperate with the investigation.

The Detective Bureau signed a total of 31 arrest warrants this month which included warrants from the Patrol Division. Over 30 hours were spent at the Muskegon County Court building obtaining warrants, meeting with prosecutors, picking up and dropping off paperwork.

On June 5, Detective Swanker and Detective Morningstar attended vulnerable adult abuse case review.

On June 26, Detective Morningstar attended the monthly Muskegon County investigators meeting.
