

Class A type crimes (more serious) were up 2% for the month and down 4% for the fiscal year. Class B type crimes were up by 27% for the month and up by 0.3% for the fiscal year. Total crimes were up 10% for the month and down by 2% for the fiscal year.

CALLS FOR SERVICE



During the month of April 2019, the Department recorded 1575 Computer Aided Dispatch events, including 1022 calls for service. A total of 705 written reports were generated during the month. The highest number of calls for service occurred on Tuesday.

TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT DATA

Department personnel issued 2 parking tickets and 246 traffic citations in April 2019, which includes those issued as the result of crash investigations. Citations were issued in 41.6% of the traffic crashes that occurred this month.

PATROL DIVISION HIGHLIGHTS

Patrol Division responded to 28 retail fraud complaints during the month of April. Nineteen complaints resulted in arrest warrants for the offender.

Patrol Division investigated seven fraud complaints. The majority of the reports were related to an online or phone scam.

Patrol Division responded to over fourteen complaints that involved individuals that had mental issues or were suicidal. The complaints that were called in came from different areas of the city which required two officers to respond. The officers assisted the people by getting them help through Health West or the Mobile Crises Team. Other times the officers transported the individual to the Community Mental Health hospital.

Total cruiser millage for April 2019 was 24,775 miles.

Training

Fifteen officers attended precision driving training. The course includes evasive maneuvers and decision making.

Two officers attended marine patrol training.

DETECTIVE BUREAU HIGHLIGHTS

During the month of April, the Detective Bureau investigated fifteen new cases. Eleven cases were cleared by arrest, warrants or other means. The remaining cases are still under investigation.

MAJOR ACTIVITIES

The Detective Bureau investigated a Criminal Sexual Conduct case in the 700 block of Pontaluna Rd. A male subject was arrested after evidence of a sexual assault was presented to detectives. The offender is currently in jail awaiting trial.

The Detective Bureau investigated seven counterfeit bill cases. The suspects involved were identified through surveillance video and positive ID from victims. The suspects were taken into custody in the Big Rapids area. All of the cases have been turned over to the Secret Service.

Detective Bureau investigated a Criminal Sexual Contact case where a juvenile victim was assaulted by their mother's boyfriend. During the investigation, an additional victim came forward and disclosed a similar assault. The subject was lodged and has been charged with four counts of Criminal Sexual Conduct.

The Detective Bureau signed a total of 60 arrest warrants this month which included warrants from the Patrol Division. Over 30 hours were spent at the Muskegon County Court building obtaining warrants, meeting with prosecutors, picking up and dropping off paperwork.

On April 3, Lieutenant VanderStelt attended vulnerable adult abuse case review.

On April 24, Detectives Morningstar, Swanker, and Pieske attended the monthly Muskegon County investigators meeting.
