



CALLS FOR SERVICE



During the month of September 2019, the Department recorded 1,417 Computer Aided Dispatch events, including 1,095 calls for service. A total of 727 written reports were generated during the month. The highest number of calls for service occurred on Sundays.

TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT DATA

Department personnel issued 2 parking tickets and 168 traffic citations in September 2019, which includes those issued as the result of crash investigations. Citations were issued in 64.8% of the traffic crashes that occurred this month.

PATROL DIVISION HIGHLIGHTS

Patrol Division responded to twenty-four retail fraud complaints during September. Seventeen cases resulted in arrest warrants for the offender. The other incidents the subject was not identified or the victim did not want to press charges.

Patrol Division investigated seven fraud complaints. The majority of the reports were related to online or phone scams.

Patrol Division responded to fourteen complaints that involved individuals that had mental issues or were suicidal. The reports that were called in came from different areas of the city, which required two officers to respond. The officers assisted the people by getting them help through Health West or the Mobile Crises Team. Other times the officers transported the individual to the Community Mental Health hospital.

During September, the Patrol Division investigated nineteen assault complaints. Sixteen cases were cleared by arrest, warrants, or other means. The remaining case is still under investigation.

Total cruiser millage for September 2019 was 27,272 miles.

On September 4, Lieutenant VanderStelt attended Coffee with cops at Biggby Coffee on Harvey Street.

On September 9, Lieutenant VanderStelt attended a meeting with Mona Shores High School and other community leaders for the planning of the Sailor Salute.

On September 18, Lieutenant VanderStelt attended the West Michigan Criminal Justice Training Consortium meeting at Ottawa County Sheriff's office.

On September 24, Lieutenant VanderStelt and Officer Neher assisted in interviews for a full-time Police Officer hire.

On September 24, Chief Gale, Lieutenant Poel, and Lieutenant VanderStelt attended the Senior Symposium at The Folker Community Hub and heard Michigan Attorney General Dana Nessel speak on her vulnerable adult initiative.

TRAINING

September was a busy month of training for the department. Two officers attended week-long Basic SWAT training in Alpena, MI. Ten officers attended driving school at Michigan Adventure. Three officers attended a Field Training Officer refresher course. Thirteen officers attended legal update. Two officers attended a two day class on forensic interviewing. One command officer attended a week-long, less-lethal instructor school.

DETECTIVE BUREAU HIGHLIGHTS

During September, the Detective Bureau investigated six new cases. All cases were cleared by arrest, warrants, or other means.

MAJOR ACTIVITIES

The Detective Bureau investigated an injured child that occurred in the 1400 block of West Norton Ave. The father of the child sat down on a hammock, and one of the posts snapped. The post fell onto the child's head, causing a brain bleed.

The Detective Bureau signed a total of 31 arrest warrants this month, which included warrants from the Patrol Division. Over 25 hours were spent at the Muskegon County Court building, obtaining warrants, meeting with prosecutors, picking up, and dropping off paperwork.

On September 4, Detective Morningstar attended vulnerable adult abuse case review.

On September 25, Detective Swanker and Detective Pieske attended the monthly Muskegon County investigators meeting.

WEST MICHIGAN ENFORCEMENT TEAM (WEMET)

The Detective from WEMET conducted several purchases of narcotics within the city of Norton Shores. 3 grams of cocaine, 2 grams of meth and a hi-point pistol were taken off the streets.

The Detective from WEMET assisted in a search warrant in the 300 block of E. Isabellain Muskegon. Detectives seized 3 grams of heroin, 57 grams of meth, and \$1,180 in cash.

The Detective from WEMET assisted in the seizure of over 3 grams of heroin, 8 grams of crack cocaine, and 67 grams of meth during September.
