Subject: Public Safety Training House Bid Opening

On June 6, 2019, bids were opened for the public safety training house. Only one bid was received from Muskegon Quality Builders in the amount of \$52,752. Unfortunately, the budget appropriation for the build was set at \$13,000; therefore I am asking that council consider rejecting the bid received.

Our plans are to review the training house bid specifications to see where any amendments can be made that would allow other builders to bid on this project.

I would be happy to discuss this with council at an upcoming City Council meeting.
