RE: Request for Qualifications and Proposals for Engineering Services, 2020 Civil Projects

I am requesting authorization to solicit qualifications and proposals for Engineering Services for a collection of small projects to be bundled into one civil engineering project. This one combined project will include the following:

- Storm sewer repairs on existing storm sewers located on Nina Lane, Wellesley Drive, Pontaluna Road and Grand Haven Road. There are four short sections in need of replacement due to multiple fractures, buckling or misalignment. Total length of all four locations is about 100-feet.
- Repair storm sewer outfall on Grand Haven Road at Seaway Drive (US-31BR).
- Cured in place pipe lining (CIPP) on existing storm sewers located on Reneer Avenue, Summit Avenue, Estes Street, Seminole Road, Broadway Avenue, and Manitou Blvd.
- Sidewalk construction along Henry Street from the existing sidewalk on Porter Road to Cedarwoods Trail and along Grand Haven Road from the existing sidewalk at Airport Road to Hidden Cove.
- CIPP of existing 1,400-feet of 24-inch concrete sanitary sewer interceptor at Hoyt Street and Seaway Drive where it discharges into the county sewer system.
- Sanitary sewer service wye rehabilitation at 30 locations throughout the city.

Request for design funds are in the current FY-20 budget.

I would appreciate it if you would place this request on the December 17, 2019 City Council agenda.
