### ADMINISTRATION

The purpose of this report is to provide information to the members of the Norton Shores City Council regarding the activities of the Police Department during the month of November 2017.

### MAJOR ACTIVITIES

Listed below are meetings and activities attended by Chief Gale for the month of November:

On November 1, Chief Gale attended the Coffee with the Police event at Toast and Jams.

On November 3, Chief Gale attended a recruitment day at Baker College.

On November 8, Chief Gale attended the C.O.P.S. board meeting in which Police Chiefs discuss area issues.

On November 9, Chief Gale attended the Rotary sponsored ENPAC meeting at the Covenant Community Church in which Law Enforcement and the community meets to discuss diversity issues.

Class A type crimes (more serious) were down by 21% for the month and down by 15% for the fiscal year. Class B type crimes were up by 38% for the month and up by 14% for the fiscal year. Total crimes are down by 7% for the month and down by 5% for the fiscal year.

PATROL DIVISION HIGHLIGHTS

Patrol Division responded to NB US31, south of Pontaluna, regarding an accident with unknown injuries. The caller advised she had witnessed a vehicle go off the road into the trees. The vehicle had lost control on the roadway and then slid off to the right, eventually hitting several trees and coming to a stop. The officer found the vehicle to be unoccupied. As the officers were checking the vehicle they noticed someone hiding behind a tree in the woods to the east of their position. The subject took off running east through the woods toward Harvey St. The officers gave a loud verbal command to stop and identified themselves as the police. The subject continued to run. Eventually the driver reached Harvey Street where he slowed down and stopped. The driver was handcuffed and searched. He was arrested and lodged at the Muskegon County Jail on driving with a suspended license and running from the police.

Patrol Division was dispatched to a business located at the 4700 block Grand Haven Rd. for a Breaking and Entering report. Upon arrival the officer met with the business owner who had called in the complaint. The victim advised that she left the business last night at approximately 6:00 pm Sunday evening (11-12-17) and arrived back at the store today at 12 noon to find that the business had been broke into. The victim discovered that three large glass display cases had been smashed. The victim explained to the officer that she rents out the glass cases. The property in each of the three cases belonged to three different subjects that were renting the space from her. The crime


scene was processed and the area was searched. There are currently no suspects and the investigation continues.

Patrol Division responded to 1300 block of E Broadway regarding a Breaking and Entry report. The victim advised that she had arrived home from work at around 6:40 a.m. and later discovered that someone had entered her home from her kitchen window. The officer located a video system that was part of a surveillance system for an area business that caught the offender entering the home. The offender was identified by the victim. The offender was located and interviewed. The offender did admit to breaking into the home without having permission. The offender was arrested and lodged at the Muskegon County Jail on the charge of breaking and entering.

Patrol Division was dispatched to the area of Crandall and York for a vehicle being broken into that was in progress. Muskegon Dispatch advised that one of the callers advised that there were kids breaking into his vehicle. The victim's wife yelled at the suspects and the subjects took off running. The officers began checking the area and saw a subject run near Clayton and Norlock. The officers located two subjects hiding in bushes and took them into custody. The officers conducted an investigation and found that there was stolen property on the suspects who later admitted that they had broken into numerous vehicles and were stealing items from the cars. Three suspects were arrested and charged for breaking and entry into cars. They were transported to both the Muskegon County Jail and the Muskegon County Youth Home where they were lodged.


Total cruiser mileage for the month of November was 21,613 miles.

CALLS FOR SERVICE



During the month of October 2017, the Department recorded 1,507 Computer Aided Dispatch events, including 820 calls for service. A total of 675 written reports were generated during the month. The highest number of calls for service occurred on Wednesday.

TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT DATA

Department personnel issued 6 parking tickets and 193 traffic citations in November, which includes those issued as the result of crash investigations. Citations were issued in 43.9% of the traffic crashes that occurred this month.

**TRAINING**

The Norton Shores Police Department spent over 90 hours in training this month. This includes all patrol and command officers.

The Norton Shores Police Department completed the yearly Use of Force training. The training covers putting officers through various computerized scenarios and justifying their actions. The training ensures that once a year we go over the use of force policy and procedures which is all documented. This is followed up with a written test and is demonstrated in front of instructors.

Two officers including one command went to a 16 hour Interview/Interrogation class. This class covers the 5th and 6th amendments and how to interview victims, witnesses and suspects. It also goes over what an interrogation is and how to read nonverbal communication.

Four officers including command were sent to their monthly Emergency Response Team training. These officers are part of the Muskegon County Response Team and train once a month. This 12 hour training focused on proper response for a barricaded gunman and responding to hostage rescue.

Two command officers were sent to a 16 hour supervision class held in Holland, Mi. This is a basic supervision class given to help the command officers have a better understanding about the organization's budgets and how to manage them.

**DETECTIVE BUREAU HIGHLIGHTS**

During the month of November the Detective Bureau was assigned ten new cases. Five cases were cleared by arrest, warrants or other means. The remaining cases are still under investigation.

**MAJOR ACTIVITIES**

The Detective Bureau investigated a carjacking complaint where the victim was pistol-whipped and held against their will for a period of time until they were allowed out of the vehicle. The offender led officers from Newaygo County, Muskegon County and the

Michigan State Police departments on a vehicle chase that ended with the offender crashing in the City of Muskegon. The offender was arrested for Operating While Intoxicated 3<sup>rd</sup> offense, Flee and Elude, and Resisting and Obstructing a Police Officer. Our case was submitted to the Prosecutor's office and a carjacking warrant was issued. The offender is currently housed in Muskegon County Jail awaiting trial.

The Detective Bureau investigated two criminal sexual conduct cases involving children and the same offender. The case was submitted to the prosecutor's office for review when investigators learned the offender had died and the cases are now closed.

The Detective Bureau is investigation four separate cases of criminal sexual conduct where five juvenile victims have alleged they were assaulted by a juvenile. The cases are being actively investigated at this time.

The Detective Bureau signed a total of 20 arrest warrants this month which included warrants from the Patrol Division. Over 20 hours were spent at the Muskegon County Court building obtaining warrants, meeting with prosecutors, picking up and dropping off paperwork.

On November 3<sup>rd</sup>, Detective Sergeant VanderStelt assisted at the Baker College Law Enforcement Career Day.

On November 9<sup>th</sup>, Detective Sergeant VanderStelt attended the case review at the Muskegon County Child Abuse Council.

On November 28<sup>th</sup> & 29<sup>th</sup> Detective Sergeant VanderStelt conducted department use of force training for the whole department.

WEST MICHIGAN ENFORCEMENT TEAM (WEMET)

The Detective from WEMET assisted with a search warrant in 4600 block of Airline Rd. Evidence collected was 5.3 grams of cocaine, and 9 amphetamine pills. Charges are pending for two offenders.

The Detective from WEMET investigated a heroin overdose in the 600 block of W. Norton.

The Detective from WEMET assisted with a search warrant in the 2000 block of 5<sup>th</sup> Street. 12.8 grams of crack cocaine, 7.25 grams of heroin, 2.9 grams of marijuana and \$960.00 in cash was seized. An arrest warrant was issued for the offender.

The Detective from WEMET assisted with a search warrant in the 100 block of W. Apple Avenue. 15 hydrocodone pills, 1.93 pounds of marijuana, and \$861.00 in cash was seized. An arrest warrant was issued for the offender.

The Detective from WEMET assisted in the seizure of over 38 grams of crack cocaine, 38 grams of cocaine, 9 grams of heroin, 914 grams of marijuana, two firearms and \$2,306.00 in cash during the month of November.
