Class A type crimes (more serious) were up by 10% for the month and down by 7% for the fiscal year. Class B type crimes were up by 8% for the month and down by 28% for the fiscal year. Total crimes were up by 10% for the month and down by 15% for the fiscal year.

PATROL

MAJOR ACTIVITIES

Patrol Division investigated and checked the sex offender list which is due at the beginning of the year. The officers checked on 70 registered offenders that live in our city to make sure they were in compliance. Anyone not in compliance was further investigated and a warrant request was sent to the Prosecutor’s Office for possible charges for obstruction of justice.


Patrol Division responded and investigated 29 retail fraud charges. We responded to different businesses from all over the city in reference to shoplifting and merchandise being stolen by both customers and the employees. Out of the 29 retail fraud complaints, 20 of them had been cleared by either arresting the suspect on site or seeking a warrant for their arrest.

Patrol Division responded to and investigated 30 alarms calls. These alarms included both residential and business alarms. It is estimated that our officers responded to at least 35 alarms per month which were false. It is estimated that 10-12 hours per month are spent on responding and checking the houses or buildings on these types of calls.

Patrol Division responded to over 130 general assist and traffic accidents this past month. General assist complaints usually involves an officer assisting citizens either by helping stranded motorists, checking the citizen's home, or assisting a citizen with civil issues. The patrol division averages five calls a day on these types of complaints. There was a high number of traffic accidents this past month again mostly due to weather related crashes.

Total cruiser mileage for the month of January was 20,581 miles.

CALLS FOR SERVICE



During the month of January 2017, the Department recorded 2,123 Computer Aided Dispatch events, including 1,007 calls for service. A total of 728 written reports were generated during the month. The highest number of calls for service occurred on Thursday.

TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT DATA

Department personnel issued 2 parking tickets and 179 traffic citations in January, which includes those issued as the result of crash investigations. Citations were issued in 54.02% of the traffic crashes that occurred this month.

## TRAINING

Twenty-eight officers, which includes command officers, attended a four hour seminar on peer group, stress and how to better cope with conflict and the profession.

Twenty-four officers, including command officers attended an eight hour Legal Update training. This training is a once a year mandatory training to assist officers regarding new laws or updated laws that will affect our officers and investigators. Legal Update is presented by an attorney who specializes in teaching police officers.

## INVESTIGATIONS

During the month of January the Detective Bureau was assigned thirteen new cases. Eight cases were cleared by arrest, warrants or other means. The remaining cases are still under investigation.

## MAJOR ACTIVITIES

The Detective Bureau investigated a child abuse involving a 1 year old child while in the care of their grandparents. Medical records showed no signs of assault or abuse but a deficiency in the child.

The Detective Bureau investigated an infant death case with Child Protective Services (CPS). The investigation concluded that no foul play occurred and the child was placed in an unsafe sleeping situation. The Prosecutor's Office reviewed the case and determined no charges would be filed.

The Detective Bureau investigated a defrauding of an innkeeper of over \$3,000.00. The investigation is complete and the Prosecutor's office is reviewing the case.

All members of the Detective Bureau attended legal update.

January 12, 2017: Detective Sergeant VanderStelt attended Suicide Death Review at Health West.

January 19, 2017: Detective Sergeant VanderStelt attended the monthly review of Muskegon County child abuse cases at the Child Abuse Council of Muskegon County.

January 31, 2017: Detective Sergeant VanderStelt attended a lunch meeting with the Lakeshore Human Trafficking Task Force. The meeting was a meet and greet with

members of the task force. Attendees discussed the needs for the task force and what area organizations can do to help.

The Detective Bureau signed a total of 50 arrest warrants and nine search warrants during the month of January which included warrants from the Patrol Division. Over 30 hours were spent at the Muskegon County Court building obtaining warrants, meeting with prosecutors, picking up and dropping off paperwork.

WEST MICHIGAN ENFORCEMENT TEAM (WEMET)

The WEMET Detective assisted with two search warrants in the 4000 block of Brunswick. Detectives seized 64 marijuana plants, 240 pounds of dried marijuana, over 3 pounds of Butane Hash Oil (BHO), and \$11,228.00. Two offenders were arrested, and are currently in jail awaiting trial.

The WEMET Detective assisted with two search warrants in the 3000 block of 6<sup>th</sup> St. One search warrant produced 6.5 grams of heroin and \$299.00. The other search warrant produced 54 grams of marijuana and \$982.00. Two offenders were arrested and are awaiting trial.

The WEMET Detective assisted in the arrest of a parolee. The detectives located 5.9 grams of heroin, 4 grams of crack cocaine, 9.8 grams of marijuana and 19 illegal pills. Also seized was \$2,331.00. The parolee was lodged and is being held on a parole violation charge and is awaiting trial on their new charges.

During the month of January the Detective for WEMET assisted in four search warrants and assisted in seizing the following:

- Heroin= 22.77 grams
- Cocaine= 53.7 grams
- Marijuana Plants= 64
- Dried marijuana= 241 pounds
- Butane Hash Oil= 3lbs 5oz
- Currency= \$6,585.00

INTERNET CRIMES AGAINST CHILDREN (ICAC)

The Detective for ICAC assisted in a search warrant in the 1300 block of Walker Ave in Grand Rapids. A suspect was arrested for possession of Child Sexually Abusive Material (CSAM). Suspect also admitted to Criminal Sexual Conduct (CSC) with a minor. Suspect is currently lodged and awaiting trial.

The Detective for ICAC completed a phone extraction for North Muskegon Police for an armed robbery case.

The Detective for ICAC completed a phone extraction for Muskegon County Sheriff's Department for a felonious assault investigation.
