SUBJECT: Public Hearing for CDBG 2019 Annual Action Plan

The 2019 Action Plan is considered as the fourth year of the Five Year Plan and incorporates the needs and projects that are projected in the approved Five Year Plan (2016-2020).

The 2019 Action Plan must be made available to the public for a period of 30 days during which time the City will accept comments on the proposed plan. City Council must also hold a public hearing during the 30 day public comment period.
