Ladies and Gentlemen:

The City Council is asked to consider appointment of Ted Woodcock, City Planner, to the Norton Shores EDC/TIFA/Brownfield Authority Board. This is a partial term, expiring on December 7, 2025, vacated when TJ Parker was recently appointed to the Zoning Board of Appeals.

The Economic Development Corporations Act, Act 338 of 1974, states that the board of directors of the corporation shall consist of not less than 9 persons, not more than 3 of whom shall be an officer or employee of the municipality. The City Planner’s knowledge and involvement in planning and development of city-wide projects will be beneficial in consideration of items brought before the board.

Adoption of the attached resolution will appoint Ted Woodcock, City Planner, to the Norton Shores EDC/TIFA/Brownfield Authority Board for the remainder of a six-year term expiring December 7, 2025.
