

Minutes: Board Member Brown moved that the minutes of the October 11, 2018 meeting be approved. The motion was supported by Board Member Larsen and carried unanimously.

New Business: Reimbursement Request – Chemical Bank, Eastowne Development

Board Member Martines moved to approve reimbursement to Chemical Bank of captured property taxes as per the Brownfield Redevelopment Plan for the Eastowne Development. The total tax capture amounted to \$117,875.34; 10% or \$11,927.49 was retained by the Authority; and \$107,347.44 was approved for reimbursement to Chemical Bank. The motion was supported by Board Member Brown and carried unanimously.
