RE: 2020 City Roadway Pavement Resurfacing Project

Dear Property Owner/Resident:

As you may be aware, the City will soon begin this year's program of Hot-in-Place (HIP) asphalt recycling and Pavement Milling and Resurfacing projects of selected roadways throughout the city. The work may begin as early as July 1, 2020, with all work scheduled to be completed by September 30, 2020. This is a moving project, so work in your neighborhood should only last a few weeks. Please see the reverse side of this letter for the exact location and type of work for each selected street.

The work shall be limited to the existing width of the roadway except when sidewalk ramps need addressing. However, it would be advisable to check the five-foot area along the edge of the existing pavement for items you wish to protect. The City cannot be responsible for protecting these items, so please make arrangements to move or protect the items you wish to keep before the start of the construction work.

In areas of the Hot-in-Place Recycling, the heat of the recycling process makes it advisable that you should remove or protect any plants, sprinkler heads, and vehicles along the pavement's edge.

Some milling work may occur before the July 1st date and placement of the asphalt overlay will occur within 14 days following the HIP work.

Access and travel through the affected streets will be limited during the work with traffic controlled by cones and/or flagging operations. Delays are to be expected.

The City would also suggest that if you have not done so already, that you sign up for nixle e-mail alerts at www.nixle.com. These alerts will provide frequent construction updates on this and other City projects.
