The above named applicant hereby makes application for a permit to construct, use, and/or maintain; or close a street within the right-of-way of _____ (Street) the exact location is as follows: _____ for a period commencing _____ and ending _____;
a detailed description of the desired facility and/or activity is as follows:

This permit, when issued, is subject to the following conditions:

1. Give notice to the City as to when said work is to be performed at least two (2) days prior to commencement of operation covered by this permit. No work shall be performed on Sundays or legal holidays unless authorized by the City. For protection of underground utilities and in conformance with Public Act 53, 1974, the Contractor shall call "Miss Dig" at 1-800-482-7171 a minimum of three (3) full working days, excluding Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays, prior to beginning each excavation in areas where public utilities have not been previously located. Members will thus be routinely notified. This does not relieve the

Contractor of the responsibility of notifying utility owners who may not be a part of the "Miss Dig" alert system.

2. In any and all operations under this permit, meet all requirements of the Michigan Department of Transportation Standard Specifications or Supplemental Specifications set forth by the City.
3. Take, provide and maintain all necessary precautions to prevent injury or damage to persons and property from operations covered by this permit and use safety devices and procedures in accordance with the most current Michigan Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices.
4. Save harmless the City against any and all claims for damages arising from operations covered by this permit and, upon request, furnish proof of insurance coverage for the term of this permit.
5. Surrender the permit herein applied for, cease operations, and surrender all rights thereunder whenever notified to do so by the City because of a default in any of the conditions of the permit.
6. Nothing in this permit shall be construed to grant any rights whatsoever to any public utilities whatsoever except as to the consent herein specifically given, nor to impair anyway any existing rights granted in accordance with the constitution or laws of this state.
7. Immediately remove, alter, relocate at the applicant's own expense the facility for which this permit is granted, if requested by the City to do so. Upon failure to remove, alter, relocate or surrender the facility pursuant to the request of the City, the applicant must reimburse the City for its cost in doing same.
8. Upon request, the applicant, if other than a governmental agency, or the contractor when the applicant is a governmental agency, shall file a bond in the sum of _____ acceptable to the City and conditioned upon performance of the conditions of the permit and compliance with all requirements of law.
9. Any operation in the right-of-way covered by this permit and attachments thereto, or the City of Norton Shores Standard Specifications, is in violation. (See. attached for any additional condition.)
10. This permit does not relieve applicant from meeting any applicable requirements of law or of other public bodies or agencies.
11. A permit as required in the foregoing application, subject to the conditions to which applicant therein agrees, is thereby granted for the period commencing _____ and ending _____. The period applied for and granted in this application and permit covers activity within the right-of-way. The obligation to operate, use and/or maintain the facility to the satisfaction of the City remains in force as long as the facility exists and is within an area under the jurisdiction of the City.
