18-019 Minutes

Council Member Jurkas moved to approve the minutes of the February 6, 2018 City Council meeting. The motion was supported by Council Member Morgenstern and carried unanimously.

18-020 Consent Agenda

Council Member Beecham moved to adopt the Consent Agenda consisting of a) Monthly Department Reports for Police, Fire, Public Works, Administrative Services and Library; b) Release CDBG Lien – Susan Hale, 4649 Susan Street; c) Authorize Bid – Sidewalk Construction. The motion was supported by Council Member Sladick and carried unanimously.

18-021 Adopt Ordinance Amendment – Street Solicitation

Council Member Moulatsiotis moved to adopt an amendment to the Code of Ordinances, Chapter 22, Section 161 Begging and Soliciting allowing street solicitation within the city limits with safety restrictions. The motion was supported by Council Member Cross and carried 8/0 on a roll call with Council Member Flanders absent.

18-022 Authorize Purchase – Work Stations, Building and Fire Prevention

Council Member Jurkas moved to approve the purchase of five (5) work stations under General Services Administration pricing through Integrity Business Solutions of Norton Shores, Michigan in the amount of \$13,411.43. The motion was supported by Council Member Beecham and carried unanimously.

18-023 Introduce Ordinance – Rental Property, Rental Inspector Authorization


Council Member Beecham moved to introduce an amendment to the Code of Ordinances, Chapter 8, Article VI, Section 8-118 [7(e)] authorizing the Rental Inspector to issue municipal civil infraction violation notices and citations related

to the enforcement of the Rental Property Ordinance. The motion was supported by Council Member Sladick and carried ~~8/0~~ on a roll call vote with Council Member Flanders absent. *and Mayor Nelund against, 7/1 52*

Comments: Council Member Bill Moulatsiotis addressed the rest of the Council during public comment to thank them for their vision in the rezoning of the vacant gas station on Grand Haven Road at Hile Road as it's been an eyesore for decades.

Tony Laskowicz and Joseph Hosler described their renovations to 4585 Grand Haven Road and intent to open a small used car dealership with a franchise feel. A public hearing will be held in March to consider their used car dealer license application.
