18-129 Minutes

Council Member Beecham moved to approve the minutes of the August 21, 2018 City Council meeting. The motion was supported by Council Member Morgenstern and carried unanimously.

18-130 Zoning Ordinance Amendment – Out of Business Signage

Council Member Cross moved to adopt an amendment to the Zoning Ordinance, Chapter 48 – Zoning, subsection (24) Out-of-business establishment, to mirror the Code of Ordinances requiring facilities that have ceased operations to either cover or place blank panels over the facades of signage. The motion was supported by Council Member Flanders and carried unanimously on a roll call vote.


18-131 Cimline Crack Sealer, MiDeal

Council Member Beecham moved to authorize the trade of one 2003 Cimline Crack Sealer and purchase of one Cimline Crack Sealer from ALTA Equipment Company of Byron Center MI through Michigan's MiDeal program for a cost of \$43,070. The motion was supported by Council Member Jurkas and carried unanimously.
