A meeting of the Norton Shores Election Commission was held Monday, July 16, 2018 at 11:15 a.m. at the Municipal Building, 4814 Henry Street.


Present: Commissioners Larsen and VanNunen; and City Clerk Stibitz

Commissioner Larsen moved to approve the Consent Agenda which consisted of a) Approve April 10, 2018 Minutes; b) Appoint Inspectors for August 7, 2018 Primary Election; and c) Approve Ballot for August 7, 2018 Primary Election. Commissioner VanNunen supported the motion which carried unanimously.

Commissioner Larsen moved to adopt a resolution appointing the City Clerk or her designee as responsible for publishing notice of a Public Accuracy Test being held no later than five days prior to the August 7, 2018 State Primary Election according to the requirements set forth by Michigan Election Law. Commissioner VanNunen supported the motion which carried unanimously.

Commissioner VanNunen moved to adopt a resolution appointing the Norton Shores City Clerk or her designee to prepare election materials for and conduct preliminary and public accuracy testing of all tabulators and voter assist terminals for the August 7, 2018 State Primary Election. Commissioner Larsen supported the motion which carried unanimously.
